SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2 (1) to (3) 4 32 35 36 45 46 49 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to The Act hereby make the following Order:-

**Citation and commencement**

- 1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Epsom and Ewell) (Amendment of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) Order 2018 (Amendment No. 3) Order 2020" and shall come into operation on 1 June 2020

**Interpretation**

- 2 (1) In this Order unless the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the same meanings hereby respectively assigned to them –  
“enactment” means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment  
“Principal Orders” means each of the relevant principal Orders listed in Article 3(a) Article 3(b) Article 3(c) Article 3(d) Article 3(e) Article 3(f) and Article 3(g)
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Principal Order

**Amendment of the Principal Orders**

- 3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order:-
  - (a) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN EPSOM AND EWELL) (REVOCATION AND CONSOLIDATION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION) ORDER 2018” shall have effect

as though for the List of Plans in the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order

- (b) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN EPSOM AND EWELL) (CONSOLIDATION OF FREE STREET PARKING PLACES AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2018” shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (c) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN EPSOM AND EWELL) (CONSOLIDATION AND REVOCATION OF FREE STREET PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS) ORDER 2018” shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (d) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN EPSOM AND EWELL) (CONSOLIDATION OF FREE ON-STREET LOADING BAYS AND FREE ON-STREET GOODS VEHICLE LOADING BAYS) ORDER 2018” shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (e) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN EPSOM AND EWELL) (CONSOLIDATION AND REVOCATION OF PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) ORDER 2018” shall have effect as though –
  - (i) for the List of Plans in the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
  - (ii) for the Third Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the First Schedule to this Order
- (f) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL HOOKFIELD AND LINDSAY CLOSE CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE IN THE BOROUGH OF EPSOM AND EWELL (CONSOLIDATION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2018” shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (g) “THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL VARIOUS ROADS IN THE BOROUGH OF EPSOM AND EWELL (CONSOLIDATION OF PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY) ORDER 2018” shall have effect as though –
  - (i) for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
  - (ii) for Part I of the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted Part I set out in the Second Schedule to this Order

- (iii) for Part II of the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted Part II set out in the Third Schedule to this Order
- (iv) for Part III of the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted Part III set out in the Fourth Schedule to this Order
- (v) in the First Schedule to the said Order immediately following Part III of the said Schedule there were added Part IV set out in the Fifth Schedule to this Order
- (v) in Article 2 (1) of the said Order there was added the following expression –  
 “highway” is a way over which there exists a public right of passage, that is to say a right for all Her Majesty’s subjects at all seasons of the year freely and at their will to pass and repass without let or hindrance and means the whole or a part of a highway other than a ferry or waterway, and includes bridges and tunnels which the highway passes over/ through”
- (vi) in Article 2 (1) for the words
  - (a) “resident”
  - (b) “visitor”
 and the meanings attributed to them there was substituted the following –  
 “resident” means a person whose usual place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is in any road or part of a road specified and described in Column 2 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule  
 “visitor” means a person who is visiting a resident and who is not ordinarily resident or resident at that resident’s usual place of abode being premises the postal address of which is in the road specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule
- (vii) in Part II of the Arrangement of Articles there were substituted the following Section –

**“PART II**

- (viii) in Part IV of the Arrangement of Articles there were substituted the following Section –

(x) in Article 3 of the Order there were substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

**Designation of such parking places**

3 EACH area on a highway comprising the lengths of carriageway of the roads specified in Column 3 of the table forming Part I of The First

Schedule and identified on the Plans for use by such classes of vehicles as are specified in Article 4 and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of not less than 1.83 metres is hereby designated as a residents' parking place

- (xi) there were added the following Article immediately following Article 3 –  
3A EACH area on a highway comprising the lengths of highway of the roads specified in Column 3 of the table forming Part IV of The First Schedule and identified on the Plans for use by such classes of vehicles as are specified in Article 4 is hereby designated as a residents' parking place
- (xii) there were added the following Article immediately following Article 9 –  
9A THE driver of a vehicle standing in a parking place during the permitted hours in accordance with the provisions of Article 3A of this Order or waiting in a parking place during the permitted hours in accordance with sub-paragraphs (1)(e) (f) (g) (h) (i) or (j) of Article 14 shall cause it so to stand or wait so that:-
  - (a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are identified on the plans so as to be in accordance with those provisions
  - (b) in the case of any parking place that is not marked on the highway that the vehicle does not obstruct in any way whatsoever the passing and re-passing of all traffic (including pedestrians) on the highway which comprises the parking place or any part thereof and
  - (c) every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking space and/or a parking place
  - (d) no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting
- (xiii) the phrase "and Article 9A" was inserted in Article 10 immediately following the phrase "Article 9"
- (xix) the phrase "and Article 3A" was inserted in Article 19 immediately following the phrase "Article 3"
- (xx) in sub-article (4) of Article 20 there was substituted the following similarly numbered sub-Article –  
“(4) Upon receipt of an application duly made -
  - (a) under the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article in

respect of the first nominated vehicle the Borough Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a vehicle of the classes specified in paragraph (1) of this Article may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one parking permit the parking permit being for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in such residents' parking place or shared use parking place indicated in column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule as relates to the usual place of abode of the applicant as indicated in column 2 of the said tables of the vehicle to which such parking permit relates by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward

(b) under the provisions paragraph (1) of this Article in respect of the second or other subsequent nominated vehicle (where applicable) the Borough Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a vehicle of the classes specified in paragraph (1) of this Article may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one parking permit the parking permit being for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in such residents' parking place or shared use parking place indicated in column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule as relates to the usual place of abode of the applicant as indicated in column 2 of the said tables by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward"

(xxi) in sub-article (3) of Article 27 there was substituted the following similarly numbered sub-Article –

“(3) Upon receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and the appropriate fee specified in paragraph (6) of this Article the Borough Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one resident's visitor's parking permit the

parking permit aforesaid being for the leaving without time limit during the prescribed hours in a parking space (where such parking space is provided) in any residents' parking place or shared use parking place indicated in column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule as relates to the usual place of abode of the applicant as indicated in column 2 of the said tables of a vehicle owned by and/or being used by a person visiting the applicant therefor

PROVIDED THAT subject to the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion limit the number of residents' visitors' parking permits that are issued at any one time in respect of a particular place of abode and may require the production and/or surrender of a used residents' visitor's parking permit or used residents' visitors' parking permits before issuing a further such permit"

(xxii) in sub-article (1) of Article 31 there was substituted the following similarly numbered sub-Article –

“(1) ANY person falling within the definition in this Order of medical personnel in Paragraph (1) of Article 2 of this Order may apply to the Borough Council for the issue of an operational parking permit for the leaving during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting a resident whose usual place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is specified in Column 2 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule in the course of medical or community care duties at those premises and any such application shall be made in accordance with formal guidance issued by and obtainable from the Borough Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such guidance to be supplied and the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue an operational parking permit to such categories of medical personnel”

(xxiii) in sub-article (3) of Article 31 there was substituted the following similarly numbered sub-Article –

“(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is employed as one of the specific categories of medical personnel and



is either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a person authorised by the owner of such a vehicle the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one operational parking permit for the leaving without time limit and free of charge during the permitted hours in a residents' parking place or shared use parking place in any parking place indicated in column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV in the First Schedule as relates to the usual place of abode of the applicant as indicated in column 2 of the said tables of a vehicle belonging to or being used by medical personnel visiting a resident in the course of their duties"

(xxiv) in Article 32 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

**“Application for and issue of a Carer’s Parking Permit**

32 (1) ANY person –

(a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in Column 2 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV of the First Schedule and

(b) is housebound and

(c) in need of regular short term visits from carers or community care personnel

may apply to the Borough Council for the issue of a Carer’s Parking Permit for the leaving in any residents’ only or shared use parking place situated (within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV in the First Schedule) on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out carer’s duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Borough Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue a Carer’s Parking Permit to such resident

(2) THE Borough Council may at any time require an applicant for a Carer’s Parking Permit or a Carer’s Parking Permit holder

to produce to an Officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a Carer's Parking Permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any Carer's Parking Permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the Carer's Parking Permit is valid

- (3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is housebound and in need of such short term visits by carers or community care personnel and that the carer or the community care personnel is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one Carer's Parking Permit for the leaving without time limit and free of charge during the permitted hours in any residents' only or shared use parking place situated (within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV in the First Schedule) on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident as a carer or as community care personnel in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the Carer's Parking Permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in the Column 2 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV in the First Schedule

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 33 and 34 the procedure validity and terms of use of a Carer's Parking Permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a Residents' Parking Permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly"

(xxv) in Article 36 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

### **“Display of Carer’s Parking Permit**

36 AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 32 is left in a residents’ only or shared use parking place (within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the tables forming Part I and Part IV the First Schedule) identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid Carer’s Parking Permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the Carer’s Parking Permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle”
