(AMENDMENT TO PARKING PERMITS)
ORDER 2022

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) 4(2) 32 35 36 45 46 49 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in the District of Mole Valley) (Amendment to Parking Permits) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on 1 November 2022_____

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order unless the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the same meanings hereby respectively assigned to them –
“enactment” means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment_____
- “Principal Order” means each of the relevant Order specified in Article 3(1) Article 3(2) and Article 3(3)_____
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment_____
- (3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order_____
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Principal Order_____

Amendment of the Principal Orders

3. WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order -

(1) The Surrey County Council Minchin Close Leatherhead in the District of Mole Valley (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 shall have effect as though –

(i) The following Section was added to Part IV in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section IV -

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	38A
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	38B
Form of childcare parking permit..	38C
Display of childcare parking permit..	38D”

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the fourth item –

“FOURTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

““childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 38A

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) in paragraph (1) of Article 2 the expression and meaning assigned to “parking permit” was substituted with the following –

““parking permit” without more means a resident parking permit or as the case may be an operational parking permit or as the case may be a carers parking permit or as the case may be a resident visitor parking permit or as the case may be a childcare parking permit”

(v) The words “and shall include a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit where applicable” were added to the interpretation of the expression “resident’s visitor’s parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number “29”

(vi) The words “or a childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “valid permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “carer’s parking permit”

(vii) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 38D” was inserted in Article 10 immediately following the number “38”

(viii) The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted in paragraph (1) of Article 22 immediately following paragraph (b) –

“(c) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(ix) For paragraph (7) of Article 22 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee in respect of a resident’s parking permit referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein

(x) The phrase “or Article 38D” was inserted in Article 27 and Article 31 and paragraph (7) of Article 33 immediately following the number “38”

(xi) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” was inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 29 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xii) For paragraph (4) of Article 29 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with”

(xiii) For paragraph (6) of Article 29 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

(i) a resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit

and that the resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only

- (ii) a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only"

(xiv) The following paragraph was added to Article 30 immediately following paragraph (f) –

"(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place"

(xv) The words "and in the case of a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place" were added to Article 32 immediately following the words "to be used" in the last line

(xvi) For Article 35 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

"No Charge in respect of a carer's parking permit

35 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer's parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months"

(xvii) Article 36 was omitted in its entirety

(xviii) For Article 38 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

"Display of Carer's Parking Permit

38 AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 34 is left in a residents' only parking place (within the lengths of roads specified in Column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule) identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid Carer's Parking Permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the Carer's Parking Permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle
PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need to be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 16 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 27 or Article 31 or Article 33 or Article 38A a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

(xix) The following Section was added to Part IV immediately following Section IV

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

- 38A (1) ANY person –
- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule and
 - (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of childcare pursuant to a contract of employment

may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents' only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 38B 38C and 38D the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

38B The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fourth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fourth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

38C A childcare parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word "CHILDCARE"
- (iii) the period during which the childcare parking permit shall remain valid
- (iv) an indication that the childcare parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid or

Display of childcare parking permit

38D AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 38A is left in a residents' only parking place within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 16 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 27 or Article 31 or paragraph (7) of Article 33 or Article 38 a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local

authority”

(xx) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Principal Order as the Fourth Schedule

(2) The Surrey County Council Various Roads in Dorking Town Centre in the District of Mole Valley (Permit Zone) (On-Street Parking Place) Order 2017 shall have effect as though –

(i) The following Section was added to Part III in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section VI -

“SECTION VI(A) – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	38A
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	38B
Form of childcare parking permit..	38C
Display of childcare parking permit..	38D”

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the fourth item –

“FOURTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 alphabetical sequence -

““childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 38A

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) in paragraph (1) of Article 2 the expression and meaning assigned to “valid permit” was substituted with the following –

““valid permit” means a resident parking permit or a resident visitor parking permit or an operational parking permit or a carer’s parking permit or a business parking permit or a childcare parking permit issued and used in accordance with the provisions of this Order”

(v) The words “and shall include a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit where applicable” were added to the interpretation of the expression “resident’s visitor’s parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number “23”

(vi) The words “or as the case may be a childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “residents’ parking place” in paragraph (1) of Article 2

immediately following the words “business parking permit”

(vii) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 38D” was inserted in Article 4 immediately following the number “36”

(viii) The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted in paragraph (1) of Article 16 immediately following paragraph (b) –

“(c) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(ix) For paragraph (7) of Article 16 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein”

(x) The phrase “or Article 38D” was inserted in Article 21 and Article 25 and paragraph (7) of Article 27 and Article 32 immediately following the number “36”

(xi) For Article 36 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Display of business parking permits

36 AT all times during which a vehicle of a class specified in paragraph (1) of Article 33 is left in the residents parking place pursuant to Article 33 during the permitted hours a valid business parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued on the front or near side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the business parking permit are readily visible from the front or near side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such business parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in such a parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10, Article 21, Article 25, paragraph (7) of Article 27 or Article 32 or Article 38A or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner as disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority”

(xii) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” were inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 23 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xiii) For paragraph (4) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents' visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents' visitors' parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents' visitor's parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents' visitors' parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with"

(xiv) For paragraph (6) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only”

(xv) The following paragraph was added to Article 24 immediately following paragraph (e) –

“(f) and in the case of a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place”

(xvi) The words “and in the case of a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place” were added to Article 26 immediately following the words “to be used” in the last line

(xvii) For Article 29 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer's parking permit

29 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer's parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months”

(xviii) Article 30 was omitted in its entirety

(xix) The following Section was added to Part III immediately following Section V

“SECTION VI(A) – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

38A (1) ANY person –

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in the First Part of the Second Schedule and
- (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of childcare pursuant to a contract of employment

may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents’ only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents’ only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified the First Schedule

and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in the First Part of the Second Schedule

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 38B 38C and 38D the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

38B The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fourth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fourth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

38C A childcare parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word "CHILDCARE"
- (iii) the period during which the childcare parking permit shall remain valid
- (iv) an indication that the childcare parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid or

Display of childcare parking permit

38D AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a motor cycle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 38A is left in a residents' only parking place within the lengths of roads specified in the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need to be so if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 21 or Article 25 or Article 27 or Article 32 or Article 36 a valid

parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

(xx) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Principal Order as the Fourth Schedule

(3) The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the District of Mole Valley (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 shall have effect as though –

(i) The following Section was added to Part V in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section IV -

"SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	36A
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	36B
Form of childcare parking permit..	36C
Display of childcare parking permit..	36D"

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the fourth item –

"FOURTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits"

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

"childcare parking permit" means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 36A

"childcare parking permit holder" means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

"two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit" means a resident's visitor's parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours"

(iv) in paragraph (1) of Article 2 the expression and meaning assigned to "parking permit" was substituted with the following –

"parking permit" without more means a resident's parking permit or as the case may be an operational parking permit or as the case may be a carers parking permit or as the case may be a resident's visitor's parking permit or as the case may be a childcare parking permit"

(v) The words "and shall include a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit where applicable" were added to the interpretation of the expression "resident's visitor's parking permit" in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number "27"

(vi) The words “or a childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “valid permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “carer’s parking permit”

(vii) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 36D” was inserted in Article 4 and Article 6 and Article 7 and Article 8 immediately following the number “36”

(viii) The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted in paragraph (1) of Article 20 immediately following paragraph (b) –

“(c) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(ix) For paragraph (7) of Article 20 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee in respect of a resident’s parking permit referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein

(x) The phrase “or Article 36D” was inserted in Article 25 and Article 29 and paragraph (7) of Article 31 immediately following the number “36”

(xi) The phrase “or Article 36D” was inserted in Article 36 immediately following the number “31”

(xii) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” were inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 27 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xiii) For paragraph (4) of Article 27 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits with

no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with”

(xiv) For paragraph (6) of Article 27 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only”

(xv) The following paragraph was added to Article 28 immediately following paragraph (f) –

“(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place”

(xvi) The words “and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place” were added to Article 30 immediately following the words “to be used” in the last line

(xvii) For Article 33 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer’s parking permit

33 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer’s parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months”

(xviii) Article 34 was omitted in its entirety

(xix) The following Section was added to Part V immediately following Section IV -

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

36A (1) ANY person –

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule and

- (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of childcare pursuant to a contract of employment

may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents' only parking place or shared use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 36B 36C and 36D the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and

terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

36B The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fourth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fourth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

36C A childcare parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word "CHILDCARE"
- (iii) the period during which the childcare parking permit shall remain valid
- (iv) an indication that the childcare parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid or

Display of childcare parking permit

36D AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 36A is left in a residents' only parking place or shared use parking place within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 14 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 25 or Article 29 or paragraph (7) of Article 31 or Article 33 a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"
