SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council London (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) (Trunk Roads) Order 1965 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on 19 April 2022_____

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Council London (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) (Trunk Roads) Order 1965_____
- (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment_____
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order_____

Amendment of the Principal Order

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though for Item 15 of the Schedule thereto there were substituted the following similarly numbered item -

"15. The London-Penzance Trunk Road (A30)

The main carriageway of that length of the Trunk Road as extends from a point 19

metres east of its junction with meadow road to a point 42 meters east of the eastern building line of No. 4 Shrub Hill Cottages"
