BOROUGH OF RUNNYMEDE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)

(AMENDMENT) (NO. 1) ORDER 2005

The Council of the Borough of Runnymede ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 (1) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers with the consent of the County Council of Surrey given under Section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

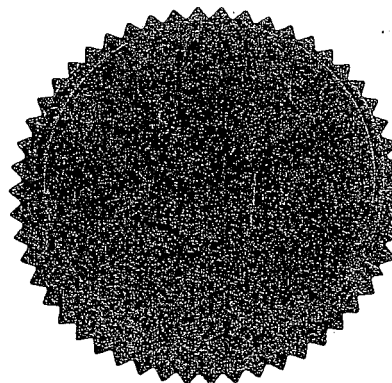
The Borough of Runnymede (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order") shall have effect as if :-


1. Schedules 17 and 18 in Schedule 1 to this Order were inserted after Schedule 16 of the Principal Order.
2. A reference to Schedule 17 was inserted within Articles 4, 5, 9, and 25 of the Principal Order.
3. A reference to Schedule 18 was inserted within Articles 4, 5, 9, 25 and 25 (2) (e) of the Principal Order.
4. The items numbered 19 and 22 in Schedule 15 of the Principal Order were deleted.
5. The Order may be cited as the "Borough of Runnymede (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on 23 May 2005.
