SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No.1) Order 2004) (Amendment No.2) Order 2008" and shall come into operation on 14 March 2008

2.
 - (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No.1) Order 2004
 - (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
 - (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
 - (4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though the items labelled "Salesian School" in the Schedule to this Order were added to the First Schedule to the Principal Order immediately following the item labelled "Trumps Green Infants School"

SCHEDULE

Salesian School	<p>(Highfield Road Site) Highfield Road, Chertsey, (south east side) from the intersection of the south eastern kerb line of Highfield Road and the extension across Highfield Road of the north eastern kerb line of Station Road continuing in a south westerly direction then in a north westerly direction along the south western kerb line of Station Road to a point 20.8 metres north west of south eastern kerb line of Highfield Road.</p> <p>(Guildford Road Site) Guildford Road, Chertsey (east side) from a point 3.2 metres north of the southern boundary of Footpath 37, in a northerly direction for 34.8 metres</p>
