SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2004) (Amendment No. 4) Order 2009" and shall come into operation on 16 March 2009

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2004
(2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
(4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment to the Principal Order

3. WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though:
 - (a) For the item labelled "Thorpe Lea Primary School" in the First Schedule to the Principal Order there was substituted the similarly labelled item in the Schedule to this Order

- (b) For the item labelled "Trumps Green Infants School" in the First Schedule to the Principal Order there was substituted the similarly labelled item in the Schedule to this Order

SCHEDULE

Thorpe Lea Primary School	Huntingfield Way, Egham, southeast side from a point 60 metres north east of the intersection of the south eastern kerb line of Huntingfield Way and the extension across Huntingfield Way of the north eastern kerb line of Langton Way south westwards for a distance of 106 metres
Trumps Green Primary School	Trumps Green Avenue, Virginia Water, both Sides, from the intersection of the southern kerb line and the extension of the common boundary of Nos. 43 and 45 Trumps Green Avenue westwards and around the turning head to the intersection of the northern kerb line and the extension of the common boundary of Nos. 43 and 45 across Trumps Green Avenue, a distance of 56.5 metres.
