ORDER 2004) (AMENDMENT NO. 6) ORDER 2015**

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((VARIOUS ROADS IN RUNNYMEDE)
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SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2004) (Amendment No. 6) Order 2015" and shall come into operation on 24 August 2015

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2004
- (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Principal Order

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though -

- (a) For the Arrangement of Schedules in the Index there was substituted the following words: -

“ARRANGEMENT OF SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools”

- (b) In Paragraph (1) of Article 2 the words “Community School” “Community Special School” “Voluntary Controlled School” “Voluntary Aided School” “Foundation Special School” “school day” and “school term time” and the meanings ascribed to each were omitted in their entirety
- (c) The following words were added to Paragraph (1) of Article 2
““school” has the same meaning as in Article 4 of the Education Act 1996”
- (d) The words “during school term time” in Article 3 were omitted in their entirety
- (e) For the word “schedules” in Article 3 there was substituted the word
“schedule”
- (f) For the First Schedule to the Principal Order there was substituted the
Schedule to this Order
- (g) The Second Schedule to the Principal Order was omitted in its entirety

Meadowcroft Community Infants School	Little Green Lane, Chertsey (north side), from the intersection of the northern kerb line of Little Green Lane and the extension across Little Green Lane of the eastern building line of No. 18 Little Green Lane eastwards for a distance of 29 metres.
Pycroft Grange School	Pycroft Road, Chertsey (north east side) from the intersection of the north eastern kerb line of Pycroft Road and the north western kerb line of the access to

	the Rainbow Nursery north westwards for a distance of 75 metres.
Chertsey Nursery School	Pycroft Road, Chertsey (south west side) from the intersection of the south western kerb line of Pycroft Road and the common property boundary of Nos. 117 and 119 Pycroft Road north westwards for a distance of 22.5 metres
Stepgates Community School	Stepgates, Chertsey (South Side) i) from a point 21.2 metres east of the common property boundary of No. 11 Stepgates and Stepgates Community School eastwards for a distance of 17.3 metres ii) from a point 62 metres east of the common property boundary of No. 11 Stepgates and Stepgates Community School eastwards for a distance of 34.8 metres
Lyne and Long cross CE Infants School	Lyne Lane, Lyne (east side), from the intersection of the north eastern kerb line of Lyne Lane and the extension of the boundary line between Lyne and Long Cross School and Holy Trinity Church northwards to a point 2 metres north of the intersection of the eastern kerblines of Lyne lane and the extension of the north western boundary of The School House, distance of approximately 58 metres.
Thorpe Lea Primary School	Huntingfield Way, Egham, southeast side (i) from a point 6.1 metres south of the common property boundary of No. 13 and Thorpe Lea Primary School southwards for a distance of 39.6 metres (ii) from a point 41.1 metres south of the common property boundary of No. 13 and Thorpe Lea Primary School southwards for a distance of 41.51 metres (iii) from a point 83.11 metres south of the common property boundary of No. 13 and Thorpe Lea Primary School southwards for a distance of 25.8 metres
Manorcroft Primary School	Wesley Drive, Egham (both sides), from the

	<p>intersection of the north western kerb line of Wesley Drive and the extension across Wesley Drive of the south western kerb line of the access to Egham and District Bowling Club north westwards for a distance of 43 metres.</p>
St Cuthbert's Catholic Primary School	<p>Bagshot Road, Englefield Green (west side) from the intersection of the western kerb line of Bagshot Road and the line drawn at right angles to the centre line of the carriageway from the intersection of the eastern kerb line of Bagshot Road and the extension of the boundary line between Tudor Gables and Pen Bryn southwards for a distance of 33 metres</p> <p>Corby Drive, Englefield Green (south side) from a point 30 metres west of the intersection of the extensions of the southern kerb line of Corby Drive and the western kerb line of Bagshot Road westwards for a distance of 33.5 metres</p>
St Jude's CE School	<p>Bagshot Road, Englefield Green (west side) from a point 25 metres north of the intersection of the western kerb line of Bagshot Road and the extension across Bagshot Road of the boundary line between Nos. 1 and 2 Vanstone Cottages southwards for a distance of 41 metres</p> <p>Corby Drive, Englefield Green, (north side) from a point 20 metres west of the intersection of the extensions of the northern kerb line of Corby Drive and the western kerb line of Bagshot Road westwards for a distance of 43.5 metres</p>
Ottershaw C of E Infant School	<p>Fletcher Close, Ottershaw (North Side) from a point 55.5 metres south-east of the intersection of the north-east kerb line of Fletcher Close and the extension of the south-eastern kerb line of Fletcher Road eastwards for a distance of 23.9 metres</p> <p>(South Side) from a point 51 metres south-east of the intersection of the south-west kerb line of Fletcher Close and the</p>

	extension of the south-eastern kerb line of Fletcher Road south-eastwards and eastwards for a distance of 43.56 metres
Christ Church CE Infants School	Christchurch Road, Virginia Water (south and south west sides), from the intersection of the south western kerb line of Christchurch Road and the extension across Christchurch Road of the south eastern kerb line of Woodside Way north westwards for a distance of 77 metres.
St Anne's Heath Junior School	Sandhills Lane, Virginia Water (south west side), from a point 4 metres south east of the intersection of the south west kerbline of Sandhills Lane and the extension of the south east boundary line of No. 26 The Orchard south eastwards for a distance of 63 metres.
Holy Family RC Primary School	Ongar Hill, Addlestone (East Side) (i) From 2.3 metres south of a point opposite the south-west building line of the property known as "Bamboo Rise" northwards for a distance of 24.9 metres (ii) from 27.7 metres north of a point opposite the south-west building line of the property known as "Bamboo Rise" northwards for a distance of 25 metres
Ongar Place Infants School	Liberty Rise, Addlestone, the entire north-east side continuing along the south east side for a distance of 21 metres Milton Road, Addlestone (East Side) from a point 14.5 metres south-east of the extension of the south east kerb line of Liberty Rise across Milton Road in a south-eastern direction for 26 metres
Fullbrook Secondary School	Selsden Road, New Haw (north side) from the far western end of Selsden Road eastwards for a distance of 30.5 metres (south side) from the far western end of Selsden Road eastwards for a distance of 30.5 metres
Trumps Green Infants School	Trumps Green Avenue, Virginia Water, both

	Sides, from a point on the north side in line with the south west corner of No. 36 Trumps Green Avenue westwards, around the turning circle and eastwards to a point 9 metres west of the eastern building line of No. 45 Trumps Green Avenue
Salesian School	(Highfield Road Site) Highfield Road, Chertsey, (south east side) from the intersection of the south eastern kerb line of Highfield Road and the extension across Highfield Road of the north eastern kerb line of Station Road continuing in a south westerly direction then in a north westerly direction along the south western kerb line of Station Road to a point 20.8 metres north west of south eastern kerb line of Highfield Road. (Guildford Road Site) Guildford Road, Chertsey (east side) from a point 3.2 metres north of the southern boundary of Footpath 37, in a northerly direction for 34.8 metres
The Grange Community Infant School	The Avenue, New Haw (south west side) from a point level with the common boundary of Nos. 11 and 13 The Avenue south eastwards for a distance of 36.5 metres
Thje Magna Carta School	St. Pauls Road, Egham (south side) from a point 3.5 metres west of common property boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 St. Pauls Road westwards for a distance of 26.6 metres
Sayes Court Junior School	Sayes Court Farm Drive, Addlestone (west side), from a point 2 metres south of the southern property boundary of the property known as "Kitale" southwards for a distance of 43.5 metres
