PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2007) (AMENDMENT NO. 5) ORDER 2012

THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to 3 and 4 and 32 35 36 45 46 49 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No. 5) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on 10 December 2012

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this Order the expression "the Order of 2007" means The Surrey County Council Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007
- (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bye-law rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2007 shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Order of 2007

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Order of 2007 shall have effect as though -

- (a) in the ARRANGEMENT OF ARTICLES - SECTION II - PART IV after the words and figures "Application for and issue of a parking permit 24" there were added the words and figures "Application for the re-issue of a parking permit upon a change of vehicle with a different registration mark 24A"
- (b) in the ARRANGEMENT OF ARTICLES PART IV there was added as SECTION II(B) and SECTION II(C) the following Sections -

"SECTION II(B) - OPERATIONAL PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of an operational parking permit 29(E)

SECTION II(C) – CARER'S PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a carer's parking permit.. .. . 29(F)

Fee to be paid in respect of a carer's parking permit.. .. . 29(G)

Refund of fee paid in respect of a carer's parking permit 29(H)

Form of carer's parking permits 29(I)

Display of carer's parking permits 29(J)"

- (c) in paragraph (1) of Article 2 there were added the following expressions which shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

" "carer" means a person who looks after another person who is either elderly disabled or in ill health and is unable to manage and/or cope by themselves without assistance

"carer's parking permit" means a Carer's Parking Permit issued by the Borough Council under the provisions of Article 29(F)

"community care personnel" means persons who are employed by or who are members of an official carers organisation operating through Surrey County Council or the National Health Service

"doctor" means a registered medical practitioner who is a fully registered person within the meaning of the Medical Act 1983 who holds a licence to practice under that Act

"medical personnel" means doctors nurses healthcare and community visitors and other categories of medical personnel operating through Surrey County Council or the National Health Service or private healthcare organisations who make house visits

"nurse" means in relation to a nurse or a midwife a nurse or midwife who is registered in the register maintained under Article 5 of the Nursing and Midwifery Order 2001 (S.I. 2002 No. 1771)

"operational parking permit" means an Operational Parking Permit issued by the Borough Council under the provisions of Article 29(E)

"permit", without more, means a parking permit or, as the case may be, a residents' visitor's parking permit or, as the case may be, an operational parking permit or, as the case may be, a carer's parking permit

"registration mark" has the same meaning as in Section 31 of the Vehicles (Crime) Act 2001"

- (d) in relation to the following expressions in paragraph (1) of Article 2 there were substituted the following meanings in replacement for the meanings currently assigned to them:-

" "Borough Council" means the Guildford Borough Council of the Council Offices Millmead House Millmead Guildford GU2 4BB

"permitted hours" means -

- (a) in relation to the parking place situate on the north side of Station Hill only and lying within the area shown marked by a black broken line and labelled as Controlled Parking Zone B on any of the plans means the period between 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive
- (b) in relation to any other parking place lying within the area shown marked by

a black broken line and labelled as Controlled Parking Zone B on any of the plans means the period between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive"

(e) for Article 21 there was substituted the following Article -

"21 (1) When a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be moved from that parking place

BUT PROVIDED THAT civil enforcement officers shall not exercise the powers in this Article other than in accordance with the 1986 Regulations

(2) Where it appears to the Borough Council or a police constable in uniform that a vehicle left in a parking place has been abandoned a civil enforcement officer or a police constable in uniform may in such manner as they consider necessary for the purpose remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be moved from that parking place:

PROVIDED THAT where the said Borough Council or a police constable in uniform propose to move such a vehicle which in the opinion of the said Borough Council or a police constable in uniform is in such a condition that it ought to be destroyed then they shall not less than twenty-four hours before removing it cause to be affixed to the vehicle a notice stating that they propose to remove it for destruction at the end of that period"

(f) there was added to SECTION II of PART IV as Article 24(A) the following Article -

"Application for the re-issue of a parking permit upon a change of vehicle with a different registration mark

24(A) WHERE a resident or a parking permit holder applies for the issue of a further parking permit due to that resident or that parking permit holder

changing the vehicle in respect of which the original parking permit was issued so that the original parking permit no longer bears the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which that original parking permit was first issued under the provisions of paragraph (4) of Article 24 then the original parking permit shall be surrendered to the Council and immediately a further parking permit will be issued to that resident or parking permit holder bearing the registration mark of the new vehicle

PROVIDED THAT there shall then be payable to the Council or the Borough Council a sum of fifteen pounds for the issue of that further parking permit which shall be valid for the remainder of the period stated on the original parking permit under the provisions of paragraph (b) of Article 27"

- (g) in paragraph (2) of Article 25 in the sixth line thereof for the words "paragraph (3) (a) (b) (d) (e) or (f) of this Article" there were substituted the words "paragraph (3) (a) (d) (e) or (f) of this Article"
- (h) sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (3) of Article 25 was deleted in its entirety
- (i) for paragraph (1) of Article 33 there was substituted the following paragraph -
 - "(1) The owner of a vehicle in respect of which the penalty charge has been incurred shall pay the penalty charge to the Council EITHER by cheque or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the Parking Services Offices of Guildford Borough Council situate at the Bedford Road Multi-storey Car Park (Level 2) Laundry Road Guildford Surrey GU1 4PX within twenty-eight days of the issue of the penalty charge OR in cash in person at either the said Guildford Borough Council Offices not later than as aforesaid OR by credit card or debit card"
- (j) in paragraph (4) of Article 29(A) in the second and third lines thereof for the words "shall not exceed thirty in each calendar year" there were substituted the words "shall not exceed one hundred and twenty (120) in each calendar year"
- (k) in paragraph (4) of Article 29(A) in the seventh line thereof for the words "may

exceed thirty in each calendar year with" there were substituted the words "may exceed one hundred and twenty (120) in each calendar year with"

- (I) there was added to PART IV as SECTION II(B) the following SECTION -

"SECTION II(B)

PROVISIONS APPLYING TO THE ISSUE AND USE OF

OPERATIONAL PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of an Operational Parking Permit

- 29(E) (1) ANY person falling within the definition of medical personnel in paragraph (1) of Article 2 of this Order may apply to the Borough Council for the issue of an Operational Parking Permit for the leaving in any shared use parking place or residents only parking place situated within the area shown marked by a black broken line and labelled as Controlled Parking Zone B on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle belonging to or being used by a person attending in the course of medical or community care duties at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in The First Schedule and any such application shall be made in accordance with formal guidance issued by and obtainable from the Borough Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such guidance to be supplied and the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue an Operational Parking Permit to such categories of medical personnel
- (2) THE Borough Council may at any time require an applicant for an Operational Parking Permit or an Operational Parking Permit holder to produce to an Officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for an Operational Parking Permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any Operational Parking Permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the Operational Parking Permit is valid
- (3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of

this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is employed as one of the specific categories of medical personnel and is either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a person authorised by the owner of such a vehicle the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one Operational Parking Permit for the leaving without time limit and free of charge during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place identified on the plans situated in any of the relevant areas of a vehicle belonging to or being used by medical personnel visiting a resident in the course of their duties

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (5) and (6) of this Article the procedure validity and terms of use of an Operational Parking Permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly
- (5) NO charge shall be payable in respect of an Operational Parking Permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from 1st April in any one year and in the case of an Operational Parking Permit which first becomes valid on any date after the 1st April in any one year shall be valid for the remainder of the twelve month period running from the said date of 1st April in any one year
- (6) AN Operational Parking Permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:-
 - (a) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
 - (b) the registration mark or marks of the vehicle or the two vehicles in respect of which the Operational Parking Permit has or have been issued PROVIDED THAT if the permit holder has the use of a pool vehicle from his/her employer then the said permit need not display the registration mark of a vehicle
 - (c) the period during which subject to the provisions of paragraph (5) of this Article the Operational Parking Permit shall remain valid

- (d) an indication that the permit has been issued by the Borough Council
- (7) AT all times during which either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used only for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of this Article is left in a shared use parking place or a residents only parking place situated within the area shown marked by a black broken line and labelled as Controlled Parking Zone B and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid Operational Parking Permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued on the front or nearside of that vehicle so that all the particulars on the operational parking permit are readily visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in such a parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 17 Article 19(H) Article 19(R) and Article 19(BB) or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

- (m) there was added to PART IV as SECTION II(C) the following SECTION -

"SECTION II(C)

**PROVISIONS APPLYING TO THE ISSUE AND USE
OF CARER'S PARKING PERMITS**

Application for and issue of a Carer's Parking Permits

29(F) (1) ANY person -

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in The First Schedule and
- (b) is housebound and
- (c) in need of regular short term visits from carers or community care personnel

may apply to the Borough Council for the issue of a Carer's Parking Permit for the leaving in any shared use parking place or residents only parking place

situated within the area shown marked by a black broken line and labelled as Controlled Parking Zone B on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out carer's duties and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Borough Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue a Carer's Parking Permit to such carers or community care personnel

- (2) THE Borough Council may at any time require an applicant for a Carer's Parking Permit or a Carer's Parking Permit holder to produce to an Officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a Carer's Parking Permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any Carer's Parking Permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the Carer's Parking Permit is valid
- (3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is housebound and in need of such short term visits by carers or community care personnel and that the carer or the community care personnel is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Borough Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one Carer's Parking Permit for the leaving without time limit and free of charge during the permitted hours in any shared use parking place or residents only parking place situated within the area shown marked by a black broken line and labelled as Controlled Parking Zone B on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident as a carer or as community care personnel in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the Carer's Parking Permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads and parts of roads specified and described in The First Schedule

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (5), (6) and (7) of this Article the procedure validity and terms of use of a Carer's Parking Permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a Carer's Parking Permits

29(G) THE fee payable to the Borough Council in respect of a Carer's Parking Permit shall be ten pounds per permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from 1st April in any one year or in respect of a Carer's Parking Permit which first becomes valid on any date after the 1st April in any one year shall be valid for the remainder of the twelve month period running from the said date of 1st April in any one year and in such a case the fee shall continue to be ten pounds with no reduction in the said fee in respect of a permit which is issued for any period of less than twelve months

Refund of the fee paid in respect of a Carer's Parking Permit

- 29(H) (1) A Carer's Parking Permit holder who surrenders his or hers Carer's Parking Permit to the Borough Council before the said parking permit becomes valid shall be entitled to a refund of the fee paid in respect thereof
- (2) A Carer's Parking Permit holder who surrenders his or hers Carer's Parking Permit to the said Borough Council after the said parking permit has become valid shall not be entitled to a refund

Form of Carer's Parking Permits

- 29(I) (1) A Carer's Parking Permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:-
- (a) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
 - (b) the words "CARER"
 - (c) the period during which subject to the provisions of paragraph (5) of this Article the Carer's Parking Permit shall remain valid

- (d) an indication that the permit has been issued by the Borough Council
- (e) the words and letter "ZONE B"

Display of a Carer's Parking Permits

29(J) AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 29(F) is left in a residents only parking place identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid Carer's Parking Permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued on the front or nearside of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the carer's parking permit are readily visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in such a parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 17 Article 19(H) Article 19(R) and Article 19(BB) or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

- (n) in The First Schedule for the item numbered 8 therein there was substituted the following Item -

"8. Tilford Road between its junction with Station Hill and Waverley Lane (at the south-eastern side of the railway level crossing which carries the Aldershot-Farnham-Bentley-Alton railway line over Station Hill) and a point 20 metres north-west of the western kerb-line of Great Austins"

- (o) in The First Schedule there were added the following items -

"10. Longley Road between the prolongation across Longley Road of the north-eastern kerb-line of Tilford Road and a point 25 metres north-east thereof

11. Morley Road between the prolongation across Morley Road of the south-western kerb-line of Tilford Road and the prolongation across Morley Road of the south-western kerb-line of St George's Road"

- (p) in the Third Schedule to that Order in the first second third fourth fifth and sixth columns thereto headed respectively "Drawing Nos. " "Date Drawn" "Rev'n" "Date Revised" "Rev'n" and "Date Revised" for the letters and numbers

"3282/WAV/24033" "03/07" "A" "01/08" "B" and "10/09" specified respectively in each of those columns there were added under the seventh and eighth columns headed respectively "Rev'n" and "Date Revised" the letters and numbers "C" and "09/11" respectively

- (q) in the Third Schedule to that Order in the first second third fourth fifth and sixth columns thereto headed respectively "Drawing Nos. - (t) in the Third Schedule to that Order in the first second third fourth fifth and sixth columns thereto headed respectively "Drawing Nos. " "Date Drawn" "Rev'n" "Date Revised" "Rev'n" and "Date Revised" for the letters and numbers "3282/WAV/24028" "03/07" "A" "01/08" "B" and "10/09" specified respectively in

each of those columns there were added under the seventh and eighth columns headed respectively "Rev'n" and "Date Revised" the letters and numbers "C" and "09/11" respectively
