(On-Street Parking Place) Order 2010  
(Amendment No. 3) Order 2023**

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 35 and 36 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

**Citation and commencement**

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council Lammas Close (D3647) Staines in the Borough of Spelthorne (On-Street Parking Place) Order 2010 (Amendment No. 3) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on 2 October 2023\_\_\_\_\_

**Interpretation**

2. (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council Lammas Close (D3647) Staines in the Borough of Spelthorne (On-Street Parking Place) Order 2014\_\_\_\_\_
- (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment\_\_\_\_\_
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment\_

**Amendment of the Principal Order**

3. WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though –

(1) The following interpretations were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical order -

““hand held device” is a device used by a civil enforcement officer which is updated from time to time with information from virtual parking transactions

“virtual parking permit” means a parking permit electronically issued by the Borough Council to a resident or carer or medical or community care personnel or resident’s visitor”

“virtual parking transaction” can be a virtual resident parking permit virtual resident visitor parking permit a virtual waiver certificate a virtual carers parking permit or a virtual operational parking permit or a virtual childcare parking permit”

“virtual waiver certificate” means a waver certificate that is electronically issued and verified by the Council

**(2)** The interpretation of the expression “Borough Council” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 was omitted in its entirety

**(3)** For the words “a certificate” in the interpretation of “waiver Certificate” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 there was substituted the words “a paper or virtual certificate”

**(4)** The word “Borough” and “and/or the Borough Council” in Article 2 and Article 12 and Article 19 and Article 22 and Article 23 and Article 24 and Article 25 and Article 27 and Article 28 and Article 29 and Article 32 and Article 38 were omitted in their entirety wherever they appear

**(5)** The following sub-paragraph was added to Article 9 immediately following the words “that vehicle” and Article 26 as a proviso and Article 30 as a proviso and paragraph (7) of Article 32 as a proviso -

“PROVIDED THAT in respect of a vehicle which is validated by the hand held device as having a valid virtual parking permit no parking permit needs to be displayed”

**(6)** The following sub-paragraph was added to sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (1) of Article 15 immediately following the words “the said certificate” -

“PROVIDED THAT a vehicle which is validated by the hand held device as having a valid virtual waiver certificate then no certificate needs to be displayed on that vehicle”

**(7)** The words “or by electronic means in the case of a virtual resident’s parking permit” was inserted in paragraph (2) of Article 23 immediately following the words “place of abode”

**(8)** The phrase “either (1)” was inserted in Article 25 and Article 29 and paragraph (6) of Article 32 immediately after the word “shall”

**(9)** The following paragraph was added to Article 25 immediately following the existing paragraph –

“(2) be a virtual resident’s parking permit”

**(10)** The following paragraph was added to Article 29 immediately following the existing paragraph –

“(2) be a virtual resident’s visitor’s parking permit”

**(11)** The following paragraph was added to paragraph (6) of Article 32 immediately following the existing paragraph –

“(2) be a virtual operational parking permit”


**(12)** For Article 38 there was substituted the following Article -

“38 The owner of a vehicle in respect of which the penalty charge has been incurred shall pay the penalty charge in accordance with the directions contained in the penalty charge notice”
