

The Surrey County Council
(Borough of Spelthorne)
(Solo Motor Cycle Parking Places) Order 2013
(Amendment No. 9) Order 2023

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 35 and 36 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and Commencement

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Borough of Spelthorne) (Solo Motor Cycle Parking Places) Order 2013 (Amendment No. 9) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on 2 October 2023_____

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Borough of Spelthorne) (Solo Motor Cycle Parking Places) Order 2013_____
- (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment_____
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment_

Amendment of the Principal Order

3. WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall have effect as though –

(1) The following interpretations were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical order –

“hand held device” is a device used by a civil enforcement officer which is updated from time to time with information on valid and invalid (expired) virtual parking transactions

“virtual parking transaction” is amongst other things a virtual waiver certificate

“virtual waiver certificate” means a waiver certificate that is electronically issued by the Council

“waiver certificate” means a paper or virtual certificate issued on behalf of the Council for the purpose of sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (1) of Article 10 permitting a specified vehicle to wait in special circumstances in a length of road where the waiting of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibition”

(2) The interpretation of the expression “Borough Council” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 was omitted in its entirety

(3) The word “Borough” and the words “or the Borough Council” were omitted from the Order wherever it occurs other than in the title and in Article 1

(4) The following sub-paragraph was added to sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (1) of Article 10 immediately following the words “the said certificate” -

“PROVIDED THAT a vehicle which is validated by the hand held device as having a valid virtual waiver certificate then no certificate needs to be displayed on that vehicle”

(5) For Article 25 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article -

“25 The owner of a vehicle in respect of which the penalty charge has been incurred shall pay the penalty charge in accordance with the directions contained in the penalty charge notice”

(6) For the Schedule to the Principal Order there was substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order
