## THE BOROUGH OF SWALE (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION No. 2) ORDER 2014

The Council of the Borough of Swale ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Kent County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Swale (Off-street Parking Places) (Variation No.2) Order 2014" and shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2015.
- 2. In this Order the expression "Order of 2011" means The Swale Borough Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 2011.
- 3. The Order of 2011 shall have effect as though
  - (i) in The Schedule thereto, the details specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall be amended.
  - (i) in The Schedule thereto, the details specified in Column 6 (Maximum period for which vehicles may wait, "Short Stay" Parking Places FAVERSHAM, Central -1/2 and Institute Road, SITTINGBOURNE, Albany Road, Central Avenue, Crown Quay Lane, Swallows, The Forum, Swale House (Open Car Park), Station Street and High Street, Milton, SHEERNESS, Rose Street, Rose Street land adjoining Wood Street, Trinity Place, Beachfields and Hope Street; shall be amended to introduce a No return for a period of 2 Hours
  - (ii) in The Schedule thereto, the details specified in Column 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall be amended to include the provision of Motor cars displaying a valid parking permit and Electric Vehicles
  - (iii) in The Schedule thereto, LEYSDOWN Shellness 1, Column 6 shall be amended,10 hour maximum waiting time with No return in 2 hours, No parking permitted between 6.00pm and 8.am during Car Park "Closed" period.
  - (iv) in The Schedule thereto, SITTINGBOURNE East Street Car Park shall be amended, and East Side Car Park shall be inserted.
  - (v) The following text was inserted into Article 3 thereto,

"electric vehicle" means a vehicle that is powered entirely or partially by electricity and is capable of being charged from an external source.

(vi) The following text was inserted into Article 6 thereto,

Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface which indicates

that a parking bay is available only for electric vehicles, only electric vehicles may use that parking place and must at all times be connected via a rechargeable lead to the charging point installed in respect of that parking place. A maximum stay of 4 hours with no return shall apply to all bays thus marked.

(vii) The following text was inserted into Article 18 thereto,

"No return requirement"

No vehicle which has been taken away from a parking place during chargeable hours after a parking event has occurred, shall until the expiration of the specified 'no return' time in column 6 of the schedule (from the time of its removal to the time of its return) again be left in that parking place.

- (viii) The following text was inserted into Article 19 thereto,Or Parking Permit
- (ix) Article 3 was amended to;

"vehicle" includes any part of a vehicle.

(x) The following was inserted in the Article
MAXIMUM PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHILCE MAY BE LEFT
The following text was inserted as Article 20a thereto

When a person removes or arranges for the removal of a vehicle from the Shellnness Road 1 Car Park in Schedule 1 to this Order outside of the permitted parking hours as shown in column 5, a release fee of £45 shall be payable.
