THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No.11) ORDER 2020

The Kent County Council, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

A - This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.11 Order 2020" ('this Order') and shall come into force on the 27th day of July, 2020.

B - The "Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019" ('the Order') shall have effect as though -

In the Schedules to the Order

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in Sheerness in the Borough of Swale

Galway Road

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule (No Waiting At Any Time) in the correct alphabetical sequence:-

GALWAY ROAD

On both sides, from the Junction with Invicta Road for a distance of 9 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Invicta Road

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule (No Waiting At Any Time) in place of the existing entry:-

INVICTA ROAD

- (1) On both sides
- (a) between points 2 metres north-east and 5 metres south-west of the Junction with Winstanley Road;
- (b) between points 11 metres north east and 12 metres south west of the centre of the Junction of Galway Road;
- (c) from the Junction with Marine Parade for a distance of 32 metres in a southerly direction;
- (d) from a point in line with and opposite the boundary of 8/10 Invicta Road, to a point in line with and opposite the boundary of 18/20 Invicta Road.

- (2) On the eastern and south-eastern sides
- (a) between points 5 metres north-east and 5 metres south-west of the Junction with Acorn Street.
- (3) On the western and north-western sides
- (a) from the north-eastern kerbline of High Street, for a distance of 4 metres in a north-easterly direction.
