(VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT No.12)
ORDER 2020

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

A – This Order may be cited as “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Parking Places) Amendment No.12” ('this Order') and shall come into force on the 10th day of August 2020.

B - “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019” ('the Order of 2019') shall have effect as though:

In the Schedules to the Order of 2019

Roads in Sittingbourne in the Borough of Swale

The following entries to be inserted into the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in correct alphabetical sequence

FOX HILL, BAPCHILD

(1) On the southern side

(a) from the centre of the junction of School Lane for a distance of 14 metres in a westerly direction;

(b) from a point 46 metres west of the junction with School Lane to a point in line with the eastern building line of 43 Fox Hill;

(c) from a point in line with the western boundary of 51 Fox Hill for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.

(2) On the northern side from a point in line with the western boundary of 51 Fox Hill to a point 75 metres west of the western kerbline of School Lane.

FOX HILL, ACCESS ROAD, BAPCHILD

(1) On the southern side from its junction with Fox Hill to a point in line with the western building line of 37 Fox Hill.

(2) On the northern side from its junction with Fox Hill for a distance of 13 metres in a westerly direction.

The following entries to replace the existing entries to the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in correct alphabetical sequence

THE STREET, BAPCHILD

On the southern side

(a) from a point 31 metres west of the western kerbline of Panteny Lane to a point 2 metres east of the eastern boundary of 93 The Street;

(b) from the centre of the Junction of School Lane for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction.

CANTERBURY ROAD, SITTINGBOURNE

(1) On the northern side from a point 2 metres west of the eastern building line of Tesco Express to a point 4 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Goodnestone Road.

(2) On the southern side

(a) from the Junction with Gaze Hill Avenue for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction;

(b) between points 8 metres west and 11 metres east of the Junction with Swanstree Avenue.

(3) On both sides from a point in line with the boundary of 215/217 Canterbury Road to a point in line with the western boundary of 51 Fox Hill.

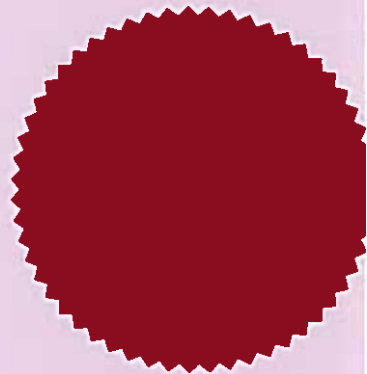
