

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT No.2) ORDER 2019**

The Kent County Council, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

A - This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.2 Order 2019" ('this Order') and shall come into force on the 17th day of June, 2019.

B - The "Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019" ('the Order') shall have effect as though -

In the Order

Taxi Ranks

The following shall replace the existing TABLE (Article 14) for Taxi Ranks:-

In the Schedules to the Order

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in Sheerness

Coronation Road

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule (*No Waiting At Any Time*) in the correct alphabetical sequence:

CORONATION ROAD On both sides, from the western kerbline of Richmond Street for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.

Richmond Street

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule (*No Waiting At Any Time*) in place of the existing entry:

RICHMOND STREET (1) On the western side

- (a) from the Junction with Marine Parade for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;
- (b) from the Junction with Alma Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;
- (c) from the Junction with Alma Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;
- (d) from the Junction with James Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;
- (e) from the Junction with James Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;
- (f) from the Junction with Clyde Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;
- (g) from the Junction with Clyde Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;
- (h) from the Junction with Unity Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;
- (i) from the Junction with Unity Street for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction;
- (j) from the northern kerbline of Coronation Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;

(k) from the southern kerbline of Coronation Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;

(l) from the northern kerbline of St Helen's Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;

(m) from the southern kerbline of St Helen's Road for a distance of 11 metres in a southerly direction.

(2) On the eastern side

(a) from the Junction with Marine Parade for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;

(b) from the northern kerbline of Alma Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;

(c) from the southern kerbline of Alma Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;

(d) from the northern kerbline of James Street for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction;

(e) from the southern kerbline of James Street for a distance of 30 metres in a southerly direction;

(f) from the northern kerbline of Unity Street for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction;

(g) from the southern kerbline of Unity Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction;

(h) from a point in line with the boundary of 91/93 Richmond Street to a point in line with the boundary of 99/101 Richmond Street.

St Helens Road

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule (*No Waiting At Any Time*) in the correct alphabetical sequence:

ST HELENS ROAD (1) On the northern side, from the western kerbline of Richmond Street for a distance of 17 metres in a westerly direction;

(2) On the southern side, from the western kerbline of Richmond Street for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.
