
THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT No.49) ORDER 2023

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

A - This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.49 Order 2023" ("this Order") and shall come into force on the 15th day of December 2023.

B - The "Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019" ("the Order of 2019") shall have effect as though -

In the Schedule to the Order of 2019

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in Sittingbourne and Milton

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in correct alphabetical sequence:

COLEMAN DRIVE On the north side, from a point in line with the western kerbline of Recreation Way to a point in line with the boundary of 9/11 Coleman Drive.

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:

HIGH STREET, MILTON

(1) On the eastern side

(a) from a point in line with the southern building line of 122 High Street for a distance of 23 metres (across the Junction with Brewery Road) in a southerly direction;

(b) from a point 4 metres south of the boundary of 92/94 High Street to a point in line with the northern building line of 60 High Street.

(2) On the western side

(a) from a point 9 metres north of the southern building line of 122 High Street to a point 1 metre north of the boundary of 97/99 High Street;

(b) from a point in line with the boundary of 73/75 High Street to a point in line with the northern building line of 60 High Street;

(c) from a point in line with the southern kerbline of Kings Mill Close to a point in line with the northern kerbline of St Paul's Street.

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in correct alphabetical sequence:

P/30/11/2023/SW/2173

KINGS MILL CLOSE On the south side, from a point in line with the western kerbline of High Street, Milton, for a distance of 14 metres in a westerly direction.

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:

RECREATION WAY (1) On the northern side, between points 9 metres west and 11 metres east of the boundary of 73/75 Recreation Way.

(2) On the western side

(a) from a point 6 metres south of the northern building line of 69 Recreation Way, north to a point in line with the southern kerbline of Recreation Way;

(b) from a point in line with the northern kerbline of Coleman Drive to a point in line with the boundary of 2/4 Recreation Way.

(3) On the eastern and southern side, from a point 6 metres south of the northern building line of 69 Recreation Way to a point 1 metre east of the boundary of 75/77 Recreation Way.

The following shall be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:

VINCENT ROAD (1) On the western side, from a point in line with the northern kerbline of Canterbury Road, north to a point in line with the boundary of 1A/1B Vincent Road.

(2) On the eastern side, from a point in line with the northern kerbline of Canterbury Road, north to a point in line with the boundary of 1C/1D Vincent Road.

(3) On the southern side from a point in line with the eastern kerbline of Ambleside for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

THIRD SCHEDULE

Roads in Sittingbourne and Milton

The following shall be inserted in the Third Schedule in the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:
