ORDER 2015

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the 1984 Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 124 of the Act of the 1984 hereby make the following Order.

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th April 2015 and may be cited as the Council of the City and County of Swansea (Prohibition of Entry Except Buses, Kings Road, Swansea) Traffic Regulation Order 2015.

Definitions

2. In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"bus" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

“Civil Enforcement Officer” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a civil enforcement officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions;

“Traffic Warden” means a traffic warden employed by a police authority in pursuance of sections 95 and 96 of the Act of 1984 and any powers or functions given to a traffic warden in this order may also be exercised by a police officer in uniform;

“Police Community Support Officer” has the same meaning as in section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002;

Interpretation

3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise
6. Unless the context otherwise requires words in the singular include the plural and in the plural shall include the singular.

SECTION 2 – PROHIBITION OF ENTRY

Prohibition of Entry except for Buses

7. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, Traffic Warden, Police/Community Support Officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to enter Quay Parade from its junction with Kings Road as referred to in Schedule 2

Exemptions

8. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall apply to buses or a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or other emergency purposes.

SCHEDULE 1

REVOCATIONS

The existing Orders are revoked insofar as they are consistent with the Schedules hereto as they relate to the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in the Schedule below.
