THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (which said Act of 1984 is hereby referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 124 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- THIS Order shall come into operation on Tuesday, the 26th day of 2011 and may be cited as "the Council of the City and County of Swansea (Revocations)(Authorised Vehicles Only) (St Thomas, Llansamlet and Sketty Swansea) Order 2011"
- 2. IN this Order:
- 2.1. **EXCEPT** where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
- 2.2. **THE** Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- 2.3. THE prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise

"Authorised Vehicle" for the purposes of this Order means a police patrol vehicle

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a civil enforcement officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions

- 3. The existing Orders are revoked insofar as they are inconsistent with the proposals contained in the Schedule hereto and insofar as they relate to the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in the Schedule hereto.
- 4. Except on the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or an authorised vehicle no person shall cause any vehicle to stop on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in the Schedule hereto

AUTHORISED VEHICLES ONLY

FABIAN WAY (ST THOMAS)

Between points 193 metres west and 204 metres west of its junction with the western kerbline of Langdon Road, a distance of 11 metres

CLASE ROAD (LLANSAMLET)

Between points 207 metres east and 218 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerbline of Pant-Y-Blawd Road, a distance of 11 metres

MUMBLES ROAD (SKETTY)

From a point 131 metres west of a point opposite and inline with the classified section of road SK0182 (the access road to Swansea University) to a point 142

metres west of a point opposite and inline with the classified section of road SK0182 (the access road to Swansea University), a distance of 11 metres
