ORDER 2014

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 and Section 124 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order.

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on Tuesday 13th day of May 2014 and may be cited as the Council of the City and County of Swansea (NOTTAGE ROAD & SOUTHWARD LANE, NEWTON LIMITED WAITING 10 MINUTES AND DISABLED, BADGE HOLDERS 10 MINUTES NO RETURN WITHIN 30 MINUTES SWANSEA) traffic regulation order 2014

Definitions

2. In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a civil enforcement

officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions;

“public service vehicle” means a vehicle carrying passengers for a fee and for the purposes of this Order public service vehicle refers to a large public service vehicle capable of carrying more than eight passengers;

“relevant position” in respect of:-

- (a) a disabled person’s badge and parking disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000; and
- (b) a permit means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;
- (c) a pay and display ticket means exhibited on the windscreen dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the ticket is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;
- (d) a waiver means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the waiver is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;

“waiver” means a waiver issued by the Council in respect of vehicles being used for building maintenance repair shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations and the Council may charge for such

waiver such charge to be determined from time to time by resolution of the Council or relevant Committee thereof

Interpretation

3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise

SECTION 2 – LIMITED WAITING 10 MINUTES AND DISABLED BADGE HOLDERS 10 MINUTES NO RETURN WITHIN 30 MINUTES

6. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 1 hereto unless the proper permit has been issued and or not exceeding the waiting time of 10 minutes.

REVOCATION

7. The existing Orders are revoked insofar as they are inconsistent with the proposals contained in the schedules hereto and insofar as they relate to the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in the Schedule hereto.

SOUTHWARD LANE

East Side

From a point 10 metres south of a point opposite the south east boundary of Nottage Road to a point 12 metres south of that point.
