ORDER 2014

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (hereinafter called “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 and Section 124 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order.

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on Monday 29th day of September 2014 and may be cited as the Council of the City and County of Swansea **(BOULEVARD (MARITIME QUARTER/ CITY CENTRE) traffic regulation order 2014**

Definitions

2. In this order, **except where the context otherwise requires**, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

“civil enforcement officer” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a civil enforcement officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions;

“public service vehicle” means a vehicle carrying passengers for a fee and for the purposes of this Order public service vehicle refers to a large public service vehicle capable of carrying more than eight passengers;

“relevant position” in respect of:-

- (a) a disabled person’s badge and parking disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000; and
- (b) a permit means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;
- (c) a pay and display ticket means exhibited on the windscreen dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the ticket is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;
- (d) a waiver means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the waiver is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;

“waiver” means a waiver issued by the Council in respect of vehicles being used for building maintenance repair shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations and the Council may charge for such waiver such charge to be determined from time to time by resolution of the Council or relevant Committee thereof

Interpretation

3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise

SECTION 2 – CONTROLLED ZONE – PROHIBITION OF WAITING, NO LOADING/ UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

6. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedule 1

SECTION 3 –PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME

7. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedule 2

SECTION 4 – LOADING ONLY AT ANY TIME

8. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or unload at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedule 3 except for loading only, at any time

SECTION 5 - DISABLED PARKING 3 HOURS NO RETURN WITHIN 3 HOURS

9. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or unload at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedule 4 except for those disabled parking for 3 hours no return within 3 hours

SECTION 6 - LIMITED WAITING 3 HOUR NO RETURN WITHIN 3 HOURS MON – SAT 8.00am – 6.00pm, PERMIT HOLDERS EXEMPT

10. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, Police Community Support Officer, a police officer in uniform, a Traffic Warden or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for a period of longer than 3 hours, no return within 3 hours, on any of the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedules 5, 6, 7 hereto between 8.00am and 6.00pm hours Monday to Saturday save for permit holders.

SECTION 7 – PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY

11. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedule 8 hereto unless the proper permit has been issued.

SECTION 8 - PROHIBITION OF WAITING MONDAY – SATURDAY 8AM – 6PM

12. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at the times on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in schedule 9

SECTION 9 - PROHIBITION OF WAITING, NO LOADING/ UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

13. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 10

SECTION 10 - LIMITED WAITING, COACHES ONLY 10 MINUTES NO RETURN WITHIN 2 HOURS.

14. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for longer than the time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 11

Exemptions

15. Nothing in Article 6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side or sides or length or lengths of the road or roads specified therein for as long as may be necessary to enable:-
- (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations

namely:-

- (i) building, maintenance, repair, shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations with a waiver issued by the Council and displayed in the relevant position on the windscreen of the vehicle;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths or sides of the road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined by the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - (iv) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or other emergency purposes
- (b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of its statutory powers and duties.
- (c) the vehicle of the Royal Mail or other universal services provider as defined in Section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2000 to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting mail.
- (d) public service vehicles when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers
- (e) vehicles picking up and dropping off passengers
16. Nothing in Article 6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13 of this Order shall make it unlawful to cause or permit Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time of which the period of waiting began) to wait on the side of the road or roads referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from the previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of the road or roads.

REVOCATION

17. The existing Orders are revoked insofar as they are inconsistent with the proposals contained in the schedules hereto and insofar as they relate to the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

CONTROLLED ZONE – PROHIBITION OF WAITING, NO LOADING/ UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

Except where otherwise regulated the Maritime Quarter which includes the following lengths of highway; Bath Lane, Ferry Side, Somerset Place, East Burrows Road, Cambrian Place, Gloucester Place, Burrows Place, Adelaide Street, Pier Street, Prospect Place.

Except where otherwise regulated the following lengths of highway; Princess Way, St Mary's Square (South), St Mary's Street, York Street, Salubrious Place, Rutland Street, St David's Place, Caer Street, Wind Street, Green Dragon Lane, Castle Square, Castle Bailey Street, Worcester Place, Castle Street Rear Access Lane, Castle Street (from a point 35 metres south of the southern kerblines of College Street/ Welcome Lane to its junction with Castle Bailey Street), Albert Row, Wellington Street (from a point 53 metres east of the eastern kerblines of Westway to its junction with Albert Row), Garden Street, Thomas Street and the access road to Oystermouth Road Car Park.

SCHEDULE 2

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME

Gloucester Place North Western Kerblines

From a point 5 metres south of the south-western boundary of No.6 Gloucester Place for a distance of 4 metres in a southerly direction. From a point 17 metres south of the south-western boundary of No.6 Gloucester Place for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.

South Eastern Kerbline

From a point 90 metres south of the southern kerbline of Cambrian Place for a distance of 7 metres in a southerly direction.

Cul-de-Sac

From a point 97 metres south of the southern kerbline of Cambrian Place , for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction. From a point 20 metres north east of the south eastern most point of the 'Mission Gallery' for a distance of 16 metres north east, then 3 metres south then 54 metres in a south westerly direction

Burrows Place South Eastern Kerbline

From a point 25 metres south of the southern kerb line of Cambrian Place for a distance of 93 metres in a southerly direction.

Burrows Place Rear Access Lane to National Waterfront Museum Both Sides

From its junction with the north western kerbline of Burrows Place for a distance of 14 metres in a north westerly direction.

Somerset Place Southern Kerbline

From a point 43 metres west of the western kerbline of East Burrows Road for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.

Thomas Street Both Sides

From its junction with Albert Row to its junction with Garden Street.

SCHEDULE 3

LOADING ONLY AT ANY TIME

Cambrian Place Southern Kerbline

From a point 21 metres south east of the south eastern kerblines of Burrows Place for a distance of 10 metres in a south easterly direction.

Burrows Place Northern Kerblines

From a point 13 metres south west of the south western kerblines of Adelaide Street for a distance of 23 metres in a south westerly direction.

Trawler Road Northern Kerblines

From a point 110 metres from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Paxton Drive to a point 10 metres east of that point.

SCHEDULE 4

DISABLED PARKING 3 HOURS NO RETURN WITHIN 3 HOURS

Burrows Place Western Kerblines

From a point 2 metres south of a point opposite the southern kerblines of Cambrian Place, for a distance of 24 metres in a southerly direction.

SCHEDULE 5

LIMITED WAITING 3 HOUR NO RETURN WITHIN 3 HOURS MON – SAT 8.00am – 6.00pm, PERMIT HOLDERS EXEMPT.

Cambrian Place Southern Kerblines

From a point 3 metres south west of the south western kerblines of the access road from Cambrian Place to its junction with the south eastern kerblines of Gloucester Place, a distance of 20 metres.

Gloucester Place South Eastern Kerblines

From its junction with the southern kerblines of Cambrian Place for a distance of 90 metres in a south westerly direction.

North Western Kerblines

From a point 7 metres south west of the southern kerblines of Cambrian Place for a distance of 12 metres in a south westerly direction. From a point 9 metres to a point 17 metres south of the south western boundary of No.6 Gloucester Place, a distance of 8 metres.

Paxton Drive Western Kerblines

From a point 21 metres to a point 43 metres north of its junction with the northern kerblines of Dunvant Place

SCHEDULE 6

LIMITED WAITING 3 HOUR NO RETURN WITHIN 3 HOURS MON – SAT 8.00am – 6.00pm, PERMIT HOLDERS EXEMPT.

Echelon Parking Gloucester Place Northern Kerblines (Cul de Sac) From a point 2 metres to a point 20 metres north east of the south eastern most point of the 'Mission Gallery', a distance of 18 metres. **Southern Kerblines (Cul de Sac)**

From a point 2 metres to a point 7 metres north east of the north western most point of the 'Pump House' public house, a distance of 5 metres.

SCHEDULE 7

LIMITED WAITING 3 HOUR NO RETURN WITHIN 3 HOURS MON – SAT 8.00am – 6.00pm, PERMIT HOLDERS EXEMPT.

Cambrian Place Southern Kerblines

From a point 11 metres to a point 21 metres south east of the south eastern kerblines of Burrows Place, a distance of 10 metres.

SCHEDULE 8

PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY

Gloucester Place North Western Kerblines

From a point 24 metres south west of the southern kerblines of Cambrian Place for a distance of 50 metres in a south westerly direction. From a point 50 metres to a point 79 metres south of the southern kerblines of Cambrian Place.

Paxton Drive Western Kerbline

From a point 69 metres to a point 83 metres north of its junction with the northern kerbline of Duvant Place From a point 12 metres to a point 21 metres north of its junction with the northern kerbline of Duvant Place

SCHEDULE 9

PROHIBITION OF WAITING MONDAY – SATURDAY 8AM – 6PM

Cambrian Place Northern Kerbline From a point 123 metres west of the western kerbline of East Burrows Road to its junction with the eastern kerbline of Adelaide Street.

SCHEDULE 10

PROHIBITION OF WAITING, NO LOADING/ UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

Trawler Road Northern Kerbline

From a point 46 metres from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Paxton Drive to a point 64 metres south then east of that point.

SCHEDULE 11

LIMITED WAITING, COACHES ONLY 10 MINUTES NO RETURN WITHIN 2 HOURS.

Wellington Street Northern Kerbline

From a point 120 metres to a point 190 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Westway, a distance of 70 metres.

Albert Row Eastern Kerbline

From a point 45 metres to a point 100 metres north of the northern kerbline of Oystermouth Road, a distance of 55 metres.

Access road to Oystermouth Road Car Park Eastern Kerbline

From a point 25 metres to a point 55 metres south of the southern kerblines of Oystermouth Road, a distance of 30 metres.

Western Kerblines

From a point 35 metres to a point 53 metres south of the southern kerblines of Oystermouth Road, a distance of 18 metres.
