DISABLED PERSONS & RESIDENTS PARKING, SWANSEA ORDER 2015

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 and Section 124 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order.

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

This Order shall come into operation on 30th day of May 2015 and may be cited as the Council of the City and County of Swansea (DISABLED PERSONS & RESIDENTS PARKING, SWANSEA) traffic regulation order 2015

Definitions

2. In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a civil enforcement officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions;

"permit" means a licence issued by the Council giving permission in respect of a particular vehicle or individual;

"public service vehicle" means a vehicle carrying passengers for a fee and for the purposes of this Order public service vehicle refers to a large public service vehicle capable of carrying more than eight passengers;

"relevant position" in respect of:-

- (a) a disabled person's badge and parking disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000; and
- (b) a permit means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;
- (c) a pay and display ticket means exhibited on the windscreen dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the ticket is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;
- (d) a waiver means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the waiver is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;

"waiver" means a permit issued by the Council in respect of vehicles being used for building maintenance repair shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations and the Council may charge for such waiver such charge to be determined from time to time by resolution of the Council or relevant Committee thereof

Interpretation

- 3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise
- 6. Unless the context otherwise requires words in the singular include the plural and in the plural shall include the singular.

SECTION 2 – DISABLED BADGE HOLDERS AT ANY TIME

Disabled Badge Holders at Any Time

7. Save as provided in Articles 9 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 3 hereto unless the proper permit has been issued.

SECTION 3 – PERMIT HOLDERS OR LIMITED WAITING WITH NO RETURN, MONDAY TO SATURDAY

8. Save as provided in Articles 9 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on Mondays to Saturdays along the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedules 4, 5, 6, & 8 hereto unless the proper permit has been issued.

Exemptions

- 9. Nothing in Article 7, 8,10 & 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side or sides or length or lengths of the road or roads specified therein for as long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely:-
 - (i) building, maintenance, repair, shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations with a waiver issued by the Council and displayed in the relevant position on the windscreen of the vehicle;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths or sides of the road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined by the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - (iv) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or other emergency purposes
 - (b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of its statutory powers and duties.

- (c) the vehicle of the Royal Mail or other universal services provider as defined in Section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2000 to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting mail.
- (d) public service vehicles when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers

SECTION 4 - PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY AT ANY TIME

Permit Holders

10. Save as provided in Article 9 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 7 hereto unless the proper permit has been issued.

SECTION 5 - PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME

Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time

11. Save as provided in Article 9 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 2

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1 REVOCATIONS

The existing Traffic Orders are revoked insofar as they are inconsistent with the proposals hereinafter contained which relate to the length or lengths of road or roads referred to in the schedule hereto.

1) PROHIBITION OF WAITING MONDAY TO SATURDAY 8AM TO 6PM Station Road, Cockett

East Side

From a point 25 metres north east of its junction with the northern kerb line of Brynamlwg Road to a point 48 metres north east of that junction.

From a point 10 metres south west of its junction with the southern kerb line of Brynamlwg Road to a point 30 metres south west of that junction.

Brynamlwg Road

North Side

From a point 15 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Station Road to a point 40 metres south east of that junction.

Gower Road

North Side

From a point 34 metres south west of its junction with the southern kerb line of Eversley Road to a point 48 metres south west of that junction.

2) PERMITS AND ONE HOUR LIMITED WAITING NO RETURN WITHIN TWO HOURS MONDAY TO STAURDAY 8AM TO 6PM.

Mumbles Road South Side

From a point 144 metres east of the east side of the car park outside the George Hotel to a point 162 metres from that junction.

SCHEDULE 2

From a point 78 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Dan y Graig Road to a point 85 metres south of that junction.

Siloh Road

North East Side

From a point 95 metres south east of its junction with the southern kerb line of Cwm Level Road to a point 102 metres south east of that junction.

Weig Road

West Side

From a point 10 metres north of its junction with the northern kerb line of Carmarthen Road to a point 17 metres north of that junction.

Wern Fawr Road

South Side

From a point 67 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Ysgol Street to a point 74 metres east of that junction.

Wern Terrace

South East Side

- 1) From a point 78 metres south west of its junction with the western kerb line of Marcroft Court to a point 85 metres south west of that junction.
- 2) From a point 95 metres south west of its junction with the western kerb line of Marcroft Court to a point 102 metres south west of that junction.

Ysgol Street

East Side

From a point 79 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Dan y Graig Road to a point 86 metres south of that junction.

From a point 8 metres south west of its junction with the western kerb line of Millwood Street to a point 90 metres south west of that junction.

Mumbles Road Southend (Confirmation Only) South Side

From a point 20 meters east of its junction with the eastern side of the parking area fronting the George to a point 92 metres east also between points 98 metres and 104 metres and 123 metres and 160 metres east of that junction.

From a point 33 meters west of its junction with the western side of Dickslade to a point 96 metres west and between points 123 metres and 145 metres west of that junction.

Overland Road North East Side

From a point 35 metres north west of its junction with the western kerb line of Western Lane to a point 16 metres north west of that junction.

Pleasant Street Morriston

North Side

From a point 24 metres south west of its junction with the western kerb line of Pentrepoeth Road to a point 44 metres south west of that junction.

2) From a point 62 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of Pentrepoeth Road to a point 112 metres west of that junction.

Queens Road Sketty North Side

From a point 92 metres north west of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Parc Wern Road to a point 136 metres north west of that junction.

South Side

- 1) From a point 18 metres north west of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Parc Wern Road to a point 71 metres north west of that junction.
- 2) From a point 110 metres north west of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Parc Wern Road to a point 153 metres north west of that junction.

Williams Street

North Side

From a point 50 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Tyn y Bonau Road to a point 90 metres east of that junction.

South Side

From a point 10 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Water Street to a point 45 metres east of that junction.

SCHEDULE 5

From a point 10 metres south east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Eaton Crescent to a point 44 metres south east of that junction.

Brighton Road

West Side

From a point 9 metres south of the southern kerb line of Cecil Road to a point 53 metres south of that junction.

Brynamlwg Road

North Side

From a point 55 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerb side of Station Road to a point 75 metres south east of that junction.

Burrows Road

West Side

From a point 10 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Vincent Street to a point 25 metres south of that junction

East Side

From a point 5 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Fleet Street to a point 25 metres south of that junction

From a point 10 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Rodney Street to a point 25 metres south of that junction

From a point 13 metres west of a point opposite its junction with the western kerb line of Craddock Street to appoint 29 metres west of that point.

From a point 30 metres north west of its junction with the western kerb line of Sketty Avenue to a point 50 metres north west of that junction.

South Side

From a point 80 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Constitution Hill to a point 85 metres east of that junction.

East Side

From a point 15 metres south west of its junction with the southern kerb line of Cwmlan Terrace to a point 35 metres south west of that junction.

North Side

From a point 16 metres north west of a point opposite its junction with the eastern kerb line of Rhyddings Park Road to a point 29 metres north west of that junction.

Gwynedd Avenue

South Side

From a point 60 metres east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Cockett Road to a point 125 metres east of that junction.

West Side

From a point 40 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Parry Road to a point 67 metres south of that junction.

North East Side

From a point 44 metres south east of its junction with the southern kerb line of Newton Road to a point 68 metres south east of that junction.

From a point 22 metres north of a point opposite its junction with the northern side of Water Lane to a point 42 metres north of that point.
