The Swindon Borough Council (Various Roads, Swindon) (Bus Lanes, Bus Gates and Bus Only Roads) Order 2014 (hereafter referred to as the 2014 Order) shall be further amended with the deletion of Ferndale Road as specified in Schedule 2 of the Order of 2014 and specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and the addition of Ferndale Road to Schedules 2 of the 2014 Order of the length of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order
