**(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES CONSOLIDATION
ORDER 2011) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER (NO. 1) 2013**

Swindon Borough Council in exercise of the powers under Sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 15th April 2013 to remain in force until the 15th October 2014 and may be cited as the Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation Order 2011) Experimental Order (No. 1) 2013.
2. Whilst this Order continues in force the provisions of The Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2011 shall apply but are varied as follows:
 - A) The plans marked tile references CK31 revision 1, CL30 revision 0, CL31 revision 1, CL32 revision 2, CM30 revision 0, CM31 revision 1 and CN31 revision 3 shall be suspended for the duration of this Order and replaced by CK31 revision 2, CL30 revision 1, CL31 revision 2, CL32 revision 3, CM30 revision 1, CM31 revision 2 and CN31 revision 4 which are attached to this Order.
 - B) The effect of the Order is to experimentally introduce a variation of the limited and no waiting and resident parking bays within Resident Parking Zones A and F.
3. Under Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Head of Highways and Transport or any other person authorised by him may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential:-
 - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic
 - (b) in the interest of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities – or
 - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.


This power shall be exercised only after consulting of the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct.
