## SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

## (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2011) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER (NO. 3) 2013

Swindon Borough Council in exercise of the powers under Sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into force on the 1 October 2013 to remain in force until the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015 and may be cited as the Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation Order 2011) Experimental Order (No. 3) 2013.
- 2. Whilst this Order continues in force the provisions of The Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2011 shall apply as follows:
  - A) The plans marked tile reference (CI32 sheet revision 1 and CI33 sheet revision 0) shall be suspended for the duration of this Order and replaced by CI32 sheet revision 2 and C133 sheet revision 1.
  - B) The effect of the Order is to experimentally introduce a 'no waiting and loading' restriction on Manchester Road on the entire length with the exception of the bus stop clearways and a loading bay. The 'no waiting and loading ' restriction will extend to the junctions with Roseberry Street, Graham Street, Salisbury Street, Gladstone Street, Ponting Street and Alfred Street.
- 3. Under Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Head of Highways and Transport or any other person authorised by him may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential:-
  - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic
  - (b) in the interest of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities or
  - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.

This power shall be exercised only after consulting of the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct.
