SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2014) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER (NO. 4) 2014

Swindon Borough Council in exercise of the powers under Sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into force on the 15 September 2014 to remain in force until the 15 March 2016 and may be cited as the Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation Order 2014) Experimental Order (No. 4) 2014.
- Whilst this Order continues in force the provisions of The Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2014 shall apply as follows:
 - A) In this Order 'match or event days' means any football match or event which takes place at The County Ground, Swindon.
 - B) The plans marked tile reference (CD36 sheet revision 1 and CC36 sheet revision 1 shall be suspended for the duration of this Order and replaced by CD36 sheet revision 3 and CC36 sheet revision 3).
 - C) The effect of the Order is to experimentally introduce a 'permit only' parking on football match days and events days on Pavillion Close and Marsh Farm Lane and introduce 'no waiting at any restriction' on the turning head on Shrivenham Road.
- 3. Under Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Head of Highways and Transport or any other person authorised by him may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential:-
 - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic
 - (b) in the interest of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities or
 - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.

This power shall be exercised only after consulting of the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct.
