
The Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (2) of section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, sub-section (4) of section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933, and sub-section (3) of section 33 of the Road Traffic Act, 1956, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of roads specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such lengths in the second column of the said Schedule.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the finetcenth day of February, 1959 and may be cited as "The County Council of Lancashire (Manchester Road and Droylsden Road, Audenshaw) (One-Way) Order, 1958".
