

THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY
(AUDENSHAW ROAD, AUDENSHAW)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) (COUNTY) ORDER 1985

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the area of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3 This Order shall come into operation on the 20th March, 1985 and may be cited as the Greater Manchester County (Audenshaw Road, Audenshaw) (Prohibition of Driving) (County) Order 1985.

Road in the Borough of Tameside
in the County of Greater Manchester

That area of Audenshaw Road, Audenshaw at its junction with Manchester Road and Audenshaw Hall Grove which is more particularly shown cross hatched on the plan annexed to this Order.
