


THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BRIDGE STREET, PARADISE STREET AND  
GUIDE LANE, AUDENSHAW) (PROHIBITION  
OF DRIVING) ORDER, 1969.

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter or leave Bridge Street or Paradise Street at their respective junctions with Guide Lane in the Urban District of Audenshaw.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as the Lancashire County Council (Bridge Street, Paradise Street and Guide Lane, Audenshaw) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1969.


