



(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1992

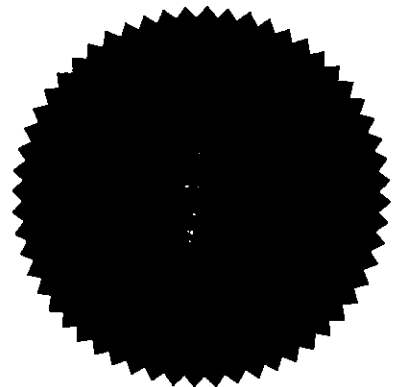
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the Link Road, opposite Park Road, from its junction with Droylsden Road, to its junction with Manchester Road, Audenshaw other than in that direction.
2. The Order shall come into operation on 10th March 1994 and may be cited as "The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Manchester Road/Droylsden Road, (Link Road) Audenshaw) (One Way Traffic) Order 1992".
