THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (DROYLSDEN ROAD, AUDENSHAW) (PROHIBITION OF "U" TURN) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2001

THE <u>TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL</u> in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) 9, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Article 2 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the
 permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden cause or permit any
 vehicle to make a "U" turn manouvre in the length of Droylsden Road at a point 35
 metres west of its south easterly footway with Lumb Lane as indicated on plan No.
 HS5307/001.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 to this Order shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulances purposes to make a "U" turn Manoeuvre.
- 3. This Order will come into operation on 15th November 2001 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (DROYLSDEN ROAD, AUDENSHAW) (PROHIBITION OF "U" TURN) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2001"
