## THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (WHITTAKER STREET AND OLD LEES STREET, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1985


THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as the Council) pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester (hereinafter referred to as the County Council) in exercise of the powers of the County Council under Section 1(1) and (2) 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in:
  - (a) that length of Whittaker Street, Ashton-under-Lyne which extends from its junction with Queens Road for a distance of 40 metres in a westerly direction
  - (b) that length of Old Lees Street, Ashton-under-Lyne which extends from its junction with Carr Street for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. This Order will come into operation on the May of 1985 and may be cited as "the Greater Manchester County (Whittaker Street and Old Lees Street, Ashton-under-Lyne)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1985".
