
THE BOROUGH OF ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE (VARIOUS ROADS) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER, 1973.

The Council of the Borough of Ashton-under-Lyne in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulations Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:

- (1) The Orders specified in Schedule 1 of this Order, each as having affect by virtue of Section 110(2) of and paragraph 1 of Schedule of the Road Traffic Regulations Act, 1967, and the Orders specified in Schedule 2 to this Order are hereby revoked.
- (2) Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in the road or any of the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road, as the case may be, in column 2 of the said Schedule.
- (3) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle when being used between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. on Sundays or 6.00 a.m. and 8.00 a.m. on any other day.
 - Provided that this paragraph shall not extend the exemption to any of the roads or lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- (4) The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if for the purposes of Section 38 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders revoked by Article 1 of this Order were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
- (5) This Order shall come into operation on the day of 1973 and may be cited as "The Borough of Ashton-under-Lyne (Various Roads) (One-Way Traffic) (Consolidation) Order, 1973".


