

THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY

(STANNEYBROOK ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE)

(WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (BOROUGH) ORDER 1975

The Borough Council of Tameside (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with County Council of Greater Manchester, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to "the Act of 1967"), and of all enabling powers (and with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Environment given under Section 84B of the Act of 1967) and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen exceeds 3 tons to proceed in that length of Stanneybrook Road, Ashton-under-Lyne which extends from the boundary with Oldham Metropolitan Borough to its junction with Newmarket Road, Ashton-under-Lyne.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article, if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road;
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to that length of road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to ^{that} length of road or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878; or
 - (d) in the course of military training operations.
3. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th October 1975, and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Stanneybrook Road, Ashton-under-Lyne) (Weight Restriction) (Borough) Order 1975.
