## (HE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (HARLEY STREET). CAMP STREET AND TOWN HALL SERVICE ROAD, ASHTON-UNDER-LYNE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (COUNTY) ORDER 1982

The Greater Manchester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to those lengths of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 16th January, 1983 and may be cited as The Greater Manchester County (Harley Street, Camp Street and Town Hall Service Road, Ashton-under-Lyne) (One Way Traffic) (County) Order 1982.
