


THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (PALACE ROAD, OLD ROAD,
ASHTON UNDER LYNE) (WIDTH RESTRICTION) ORDER 1987

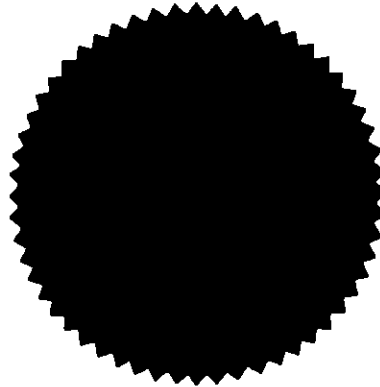
The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby makes the following order.

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this order, no person shall cause any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load of the vehicle, exceeds 6 feet 6 inches, to proceed in that length of Palace Road in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside, which extends from a point 74m east of Queens Road for a distance of 3m in an easterly direction.
2. This order shall come into operation on the 16th June 1987 and may be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough (Palace Road, Old Road, Ashton-under-Lyne) (Width Restriction) Order 1987.
