**THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(NEWTON STREET, HYDE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING
AND LOADING AND PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 2007**

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges For Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000, or the Chronically Sick & Disabled Persons Act 1970.

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

(ii) ~~in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen,~~ the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and

(b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

(3) except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.


2. Save as provided in Articles 3, no person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in a southerly direction on Newton Street to make a right turn into Dukinfield Road.
3. Nothing in Articles 2 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any vehicle being used for Ambulance, Fire Brigade or Police purposes if the observance of any provision of this Order would hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose on which it is being used on that occasion.

- (3) Nothing in Articles 4 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day) provided that such periods lies entirely within the period during which the exemption as to loading and unloading specified in paragraph (2) of this Article.
6. THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (HYDE TOWN CENTRE BY-PASS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 1987 Shall have the effect as though in Schedule 1 to that Order the sides of length of road "Newton Street" were deleted therefrom.
7. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

The Order shall come into operation on the 27th day of September 2007 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (NEWTON STREET, HYDE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2007".
