THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (GODLEY HILL AREA, HYDE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2014

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in on that length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the specified length of road:-
 - (a) if the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (b) if the vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or any other authority in exercise of statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used in such service or in such connection it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the specified length of road;
 - (c) if the vehicle is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day February 2014 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (GODLEY HILL AREA, HYDE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2014"

Unnamed Road
