TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(HATTERSLEY ROAD WEST, HYDE)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2014

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in on that length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the specified length of road:-
 - (a) if the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (b) if the vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or any other authority in exercise of statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used in such service or in such connection it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the specified length of road;
 - (c) if the vehicle is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

This Order shall come into operation on the 20th October 2014 and may be cited as "**TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (HATTERSLEY ROAD WEST, HYDE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2014**"

SCHEDULE

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Hattersley Road West - from a point 85 metres east of its junction with Fields Farm Road in an easterly direction (approximately 35 metres) to the back of the northerly footway of the realigned Hattersley Road West.
