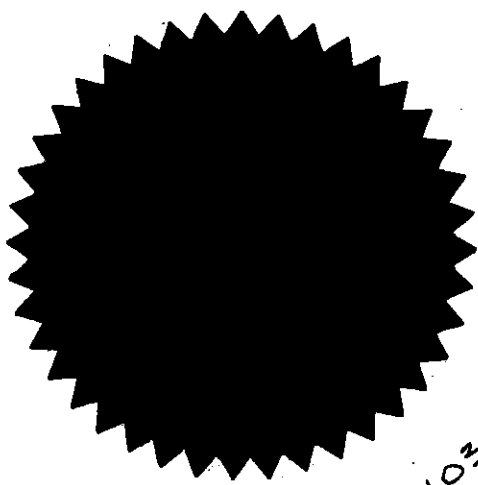
THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF TAMESIDE (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section(s) 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84c(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than specified in the said Schedule.
2. The Order shall come into operation on the *tenth* day of *March* 1980 and may be cited as "THE GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY (BROADBOTTOM GENERAL IMPROVEMENT AREA) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1980".
