

TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

(BESTHILL BRIDGE BROADBOTTOM)(WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1989

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (hereinafter referred to as the Council) in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and 2, 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause:-

- (a) any motor vehicle or trailer, being a track laying vehicle or,
- (b) any goods vehicle which exceeds a maximum of 7.5 tonnes gross weight;

to proceed over Besthill Bridge, Broadbottom, (Tameside/Derbyshire border) over the River Etherow.


2. Nothing in Article 1 shall apply to the following vehicles, that is to say:-

- (a) vehicles when used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (b) vehicles when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) public service vehicles.

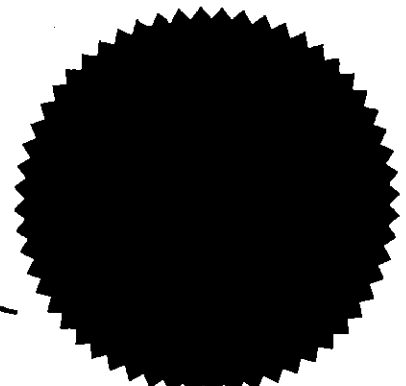
3. The County of Chester (Market Street/Mottram Road C431 Mottram and Broadbottom, Longendale U.D.)(Weight Restriction) Order 1973 is hereby revoked.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 19th day of April 1990 and may be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough (Besthill Bridge, Broadbottom)(Weight Restriction) Order 1987.

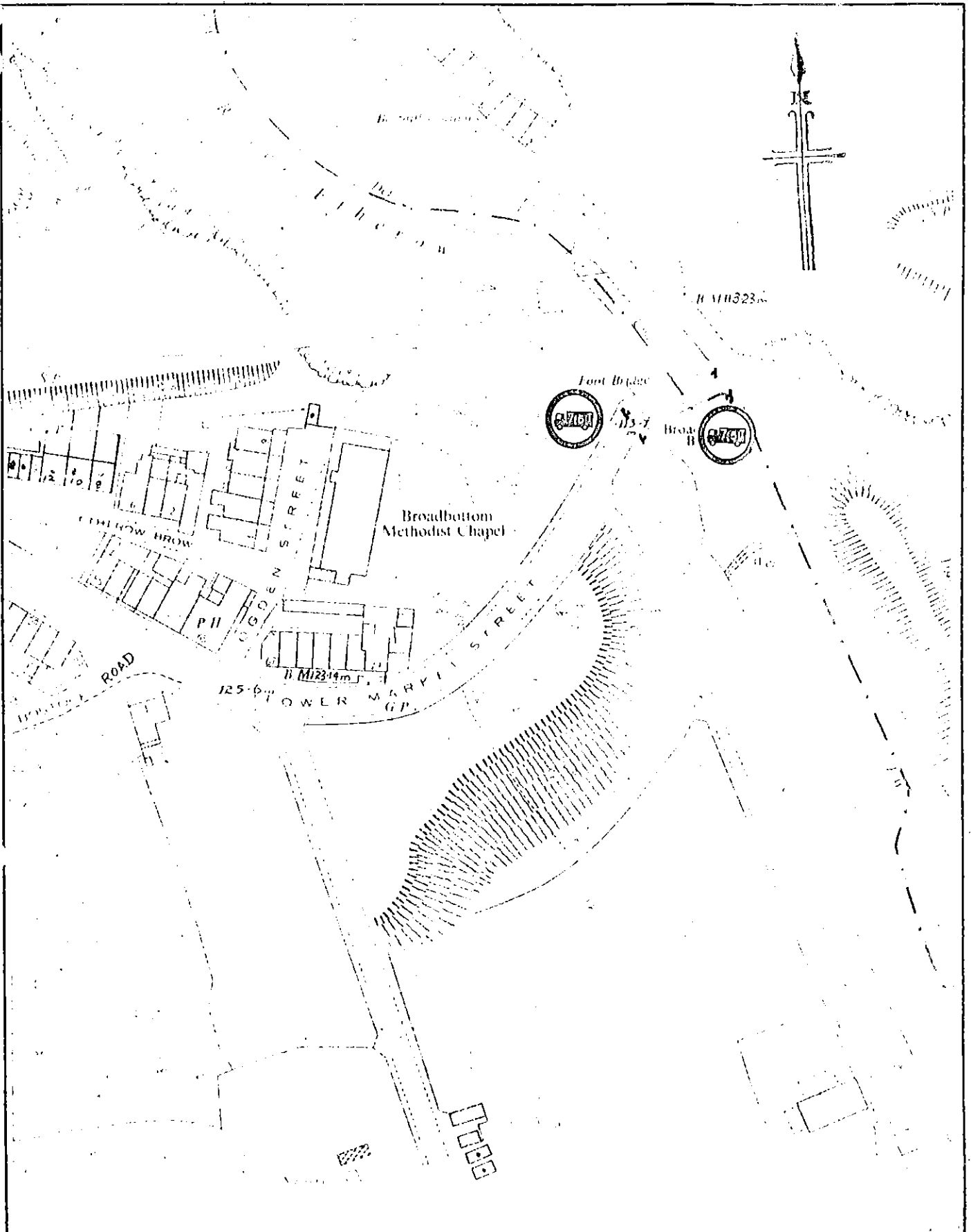
