THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-


- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- Any existing Order, by virtue of which Roe Cross Road became a derestricted road, is hereby revoked.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ROE CROSS ROAD, MOTTRAM-IN-LONGDENDALE) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1993" and shall come into operation on 18th March 1993.

SCHEDULE

That length of Roe Cross Road which extends from a point 100 metres north west of its junction with Old Road to a point 106 metres south west of its junction with Matley Lane, a distance of approximately 790 metres.
