
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- The roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CHESTER (RESTRICTED ROADS) (No.2) ORDER 1965 is hereby revoked.
- THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CHESTER (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (No.3) ORDER 1965 is hereby revoked.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ROE CROSS ROAD, BACKMOOR and STALYBRIDGE ROAD, MOTTRAM IN LONGDENDALE) (RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER 1993" and shall come into operation on 18th March 1993

SCHEDULE

- Roecross Road between Old Road and a point 100 metres north west of Old Road;
- 2. Backmoor between Old Road and Mottram Moor;
- Stalybridge Road between Backmoor and a point 69 metres from its junction with Mottram Moor.
