THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (BACK MOOR, MOTTRAM-IN-LONGDENDALE) (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) ORDER 1997

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

- Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in a south-easterly direction in Back Moor in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside shall cause that vehicle upon reaching the junction of Back Moor with Mottram Moor, to make a left hand turn into Mottram Moor.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any person causing any vehicle to access Number 14 Mottram Moor.
- 3. The Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of April 1997 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (BACK MOOR, MOTTRAM-IN-LONGDENDALE) (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) ORDER 1997"
