(BACK MOOR, MOTTRAM-IN-LONGDENDALE)
(PRESCRIBED ROUTE) ORDER 1997

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in a south-easterly direction in Back Moor in the Metropolitan Borough of Tameside shall cause that vehicle upon reaching the junction of Back Moor with Mottram Moor, to make a left hand turn into Mottram Moor.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any person causing any vehicle to access Number 14 Mottram Moor.
3. The Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of April 1997 and may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (BACK MOOR, MOTTRAM-IN-LONGDENDALE) (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) ORDER 1997"
