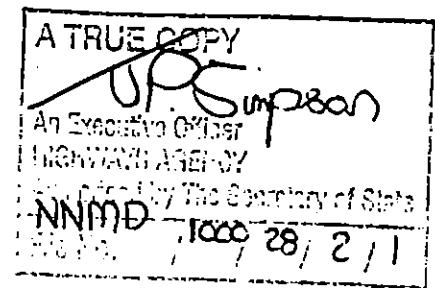

ROAD TRAFFIC

A628 TRUNK ROAD (MANCHESTER ROAD, TINTWISTLE AND HOLLINGWORTH)

(30 AND 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1998

Made 25 March 1998

Coming into force 30 March 1998

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1)(a) and (2) and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into force on 30 March 1998 and may be cited as the A628 Trunk Road (Manchester Road, Tintwistle And Hollingworth) (30 and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1998.
2. The length of trunk road, as specified in the Schedule, Item 1, to this Order, shall be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road as specified in the Schedule, Item 2, to this Order.
4. The provisions of paragraph 2 of the Schedule of The County Council of the County Palatine of Chester (Built-Up Areas) Order 1936 (No. 5) are hereby varied in relation to the length of trunk road specified in item 2 of the Schedule to this Order.

THE SCHEDULE

1. The A628 Trunk Road, known as Manchester Road in the District of Tameside in the County of Greater Manchester, from a point 110 metres south of the centre line of the Derbyshire/Greater Manchester County Boundary, southwards for a distance of 90 metres.
2. The A628 Trunk Road, known as Manchester Road in the Districts of High Peak and Tameside in the Counties of Derbyshire and Greater Manchester from a point 46 metres west of the junction with Crossgates Lane southwards to a point 110 metres south of the Derbyshire / Greater Manchester boundary.
