

CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCILTHE COUNTY OF CHESTER (EARNSHAW STREET AND LORD STREET, HOLLINGWORTH)
(ONE WAY) ORDER 1968

The Cheshire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 1 and subsection (4) of Section 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of January One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine and may be cited as "The County of Chester (Earnshaw Street and Lord Street, Hollingworth) (One Way) Order 1968".
