CITY COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASHIRE
(STAMFORD STREET AND WATERTON LANE, MOSSLEY)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER, 1961

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers under subsection (1), (2) and (3) of Section 26 and subsection (4) of Section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 and of all other powers then enabling it hereby do hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such length in the second column of the said Schedule.

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building, operation or demolition, the removal or any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road, or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878; or

- (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road.

4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the fourteenth day of July, 1961, and may be cited as "The County Council of Lancashire (Stamford Street and Waterton Lane, Mossley) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1961."
