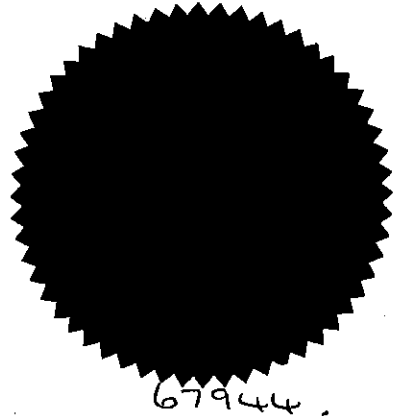
THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under section 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Any existing Order, by virtue of which Manchester Road, Mossley became a derestricted road, is hereby revoked.
3. The County Council of Lancaster, 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit (No.3) Order 1969 made under the ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (MANCHESTER ROAD, MOSSLEY) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1995" and shall come into operation on

40 miles per hour speed limit

Manchester Road - **from Blackrock Bridge to a point 82 metres south
of its junction with Egmont Street.**
