
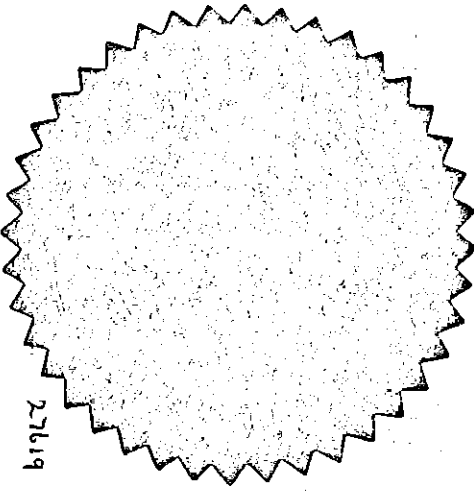


The Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (2) of section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, sub-section (4) of section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933 and sub-section (3) of section 33 of the Road Traffic Act, 1956, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such road in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of January 1960 and may be cited as 'The County Council of Lancashire (Roughtown Road, Mossley) (One-Way) Order, 1960.
