

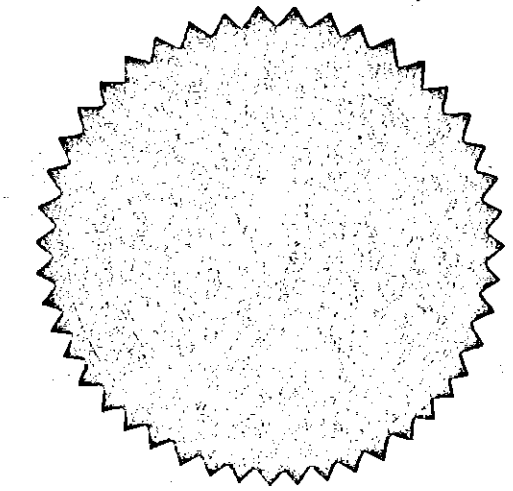


THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(STAMFORD STREET AND ARUNDEL STREET, A.670 MOSSLEY)  
(ONE-WAY) ORDER 1965

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to those lengths in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the Twentieth day of April 1965 and may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Stamford Street and Arundel Street, A.670 Mossley) (One-Way) Order 1965".
