THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
(MILL STREET, MOSSLEY)
(WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1999

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. In this Order:-

"maximum gross weight" has the same meaning as in the (Road Vehicles Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;

2. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall except with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle which exceeds 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

3. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads referred to therein if the vehicle is being used for any of the following:-

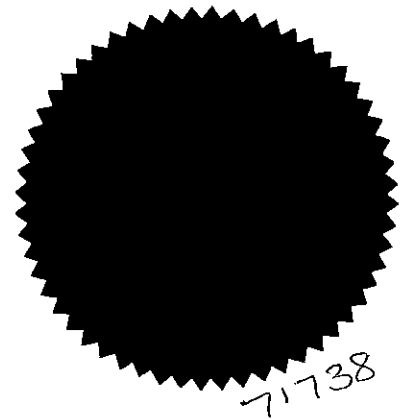
- (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair, in, or in land adjacent to the lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (v) in the service of a local authority or any other authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (b) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle to be used for the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of roads;

- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - (e) the vehicle to be used for agricultural purposes in land adjacent to any of the said lengths of roads.
4. THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASHIRE (MILL STREET, MOSSLEY)
(PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1959 shall hereby be revoked.

This Order shall come into operation on the 30th June 1999 and may be cited as the "THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (MILL STREET, MOSSLEY) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1999".
